A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, DEDICATING AND ACCEPTING A PORTION OF HUNTER PARK AS PUBLIC STREETS.

BE IT RESCLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside:

That the herein described portion of Hunter Park owned by the City of Riverside be and is hereby dedicated by the City of Riverside and accepted for public use for street purposes, to become and be known as parts of IOWA and COLUMBIA AVENUES.

Said parcel or strip of land is located in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and is described as follows:

That portion of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 18, Townshio 2 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the southerly

line of Columbia Avenue (66 feet wide) with the westerly line of Iowa Avenue (100 feet wide);

Thence North 89° 55' 30" West, along said southerly line of Columbia Avenue, 1,153.03 feet to a line which is parallel with and distant 1,203.00 feet westerly as measured at right angle to the centerline of said Iowa Avenue;

Thence South 00° 21' 14" East, along said parallel line, 22.00 feet to its intersection with a line which is parallel with and distant 55.00 feet southerly as measured at right angle to the centerline of said Columbia Avenue;

Thence South 89° 55' 30" East, along said parallel line, a distance of 1,124.71 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve concaving southwesterly and having a radius of 23.50 feet;

Thence southeasterly along said curve an arc length 36.74 feet thru a central angle of 89° 34' 16" to a line which is parallel with and distant 55.00 feet westerly as measured at right angle to said centerline of said Iowa Avenue;

Thence South 00° 21' 14" East, along said parallel line, 1,187.13 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve concaving northwesterly and having a radius of 23.50 feet;

Thence southwesterly along said curve an arc length of 37.09 feet thru a central angle of 90° 25' 13" to its intersection with the northerly line of Marlborough Avenue; said northerly line being parallel with and distant 33.00 feet northerly as measured at right angle to the centerline of said Marlborough Avenue; Thence South 89° 56' 01" East, 28.67 feet along

said northerly line to its intersection with said westerly

line of said Iowa Avenue;
Thence North 00° 21' 14" West, along said westerly line a distance of 1,256.12 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded by the County Recorder of Riverside County.
