LICENSE AGREEMENT Winstrom (Winsterm Crossing)

BUK

On this day of , 1970, the CITY OF RIVERSIDE ("City") and THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY ("Company") hereby mutually agree as follows:

City hereby grants permission to Company to cross the Winstrom Riverside Water Company Canal at Winstorm Street in the City Fyliof Riverside, State of California, with a cable attached to a bridge crossing the canal as per construction diagrams attached, showing a plan and profile of this crossing.

Said installation shall be subject to the following conditions to which the Company agrees:

- 1. The cable shall be attached in accordance with the plan and profile as attached hereto.
- 2. The bridge shall be kept in an "open" condition at all times.
- 3. No work shall be commenced until this License is signed by all parties.
- 4. The crossing shall proceed quickly to completion and not allow undue interruptions with traffic on the bridge.
- 5. In accepting this License, Company agrees to hold City harmless from any claims of liability and demands or actions for damages and any and every cost and expense connected therewith arising in connection with the work of installation of the facilities for which this License has been granted.
- 6. This License and all rights herein granted are personal to Company and may not be assigned or otherwise transferred without the prior written consent of City, except in connection with a transfer of all or substantially all of its business.
  - 7. The Company shall remove or relocate the cable

at its own cost at the request of the City if the City removes, replaces, reconstructs, widens or otherwise alters bridge crossing.

- . 8. This license is revocable upon thirty days' written notice by the City.
- 9. Neither this agreement nor any part thereof shall be construed as an admission or denial of the existence or non-existence of any right or duty of the Company or of the City under Section 7901 of the Public Utilities Code.


