This survey was mode for the purpose of establishing the east line of that parcel of land described in Book 158, page 413 of Official Records on file in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California. While the Deed recites that the South boundary of the above mentioned parcel is 575.3 feet in length, the distance to a rock monument in the center of Palmyrita Ave. at the south-east corner of the above mentioned parcel which is the accepted corner by all interested parties is 576.15 feet measured from the South-west corner of Section 8.

It is evident that this rock monument has been recognized by the interested owners, due to the fact that an old concrete flume and a building were constructed to conform to this line.

This rock monument was recognized and used by A.C. Fulmor G.E. April 3, 1911, on a survey made for the National Orange Co. the owners at that time of the exception in the above mentioned deed.

I hereby certify that I am a Registered Civil Engineer of the State of California, that this map consisting of one (1) sheet correctly represents a survey made under my supervision in Jan. 1942; that all the monuments shown hereon actually exist and their positions are correctly shown.
