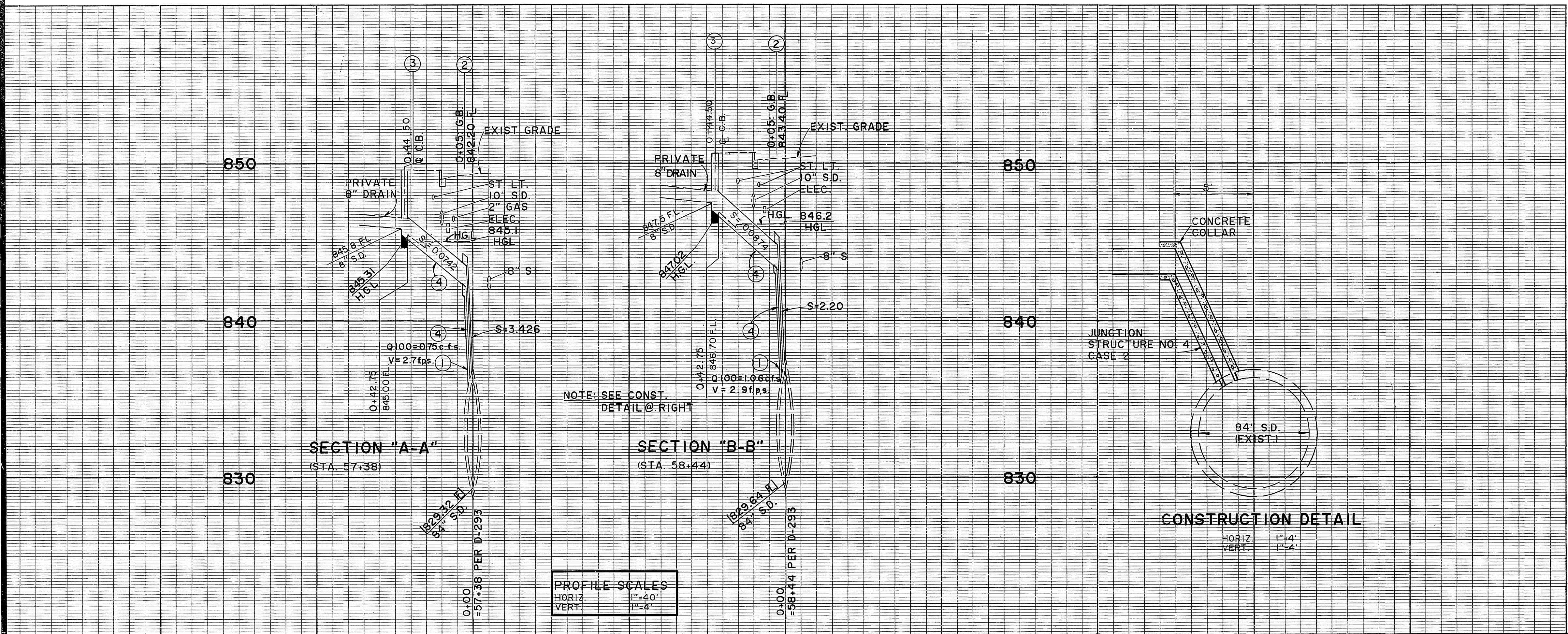


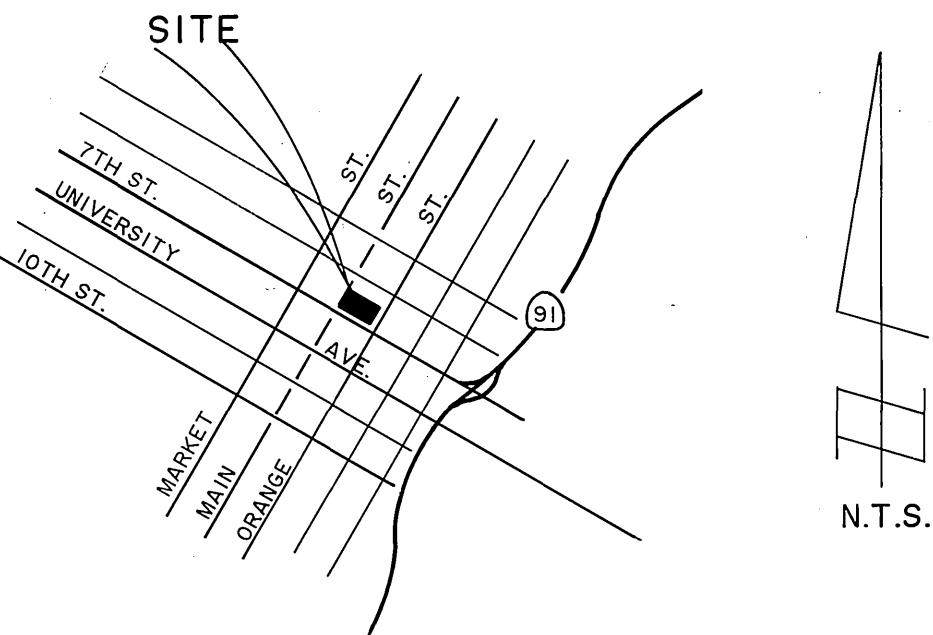
STORM DRAIN NOTES

- Construction shall be in accordance with the City of Riverside Dept. of Public Works, Standard Drawings, and the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction, Current Edition.
- It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to clear the right of way in accordance with the provisions of law as it affects each utility including irrigation lines and appurtenances and at no cost to the City.
- Notice to contractor. The existence and location of any underground utility pipes or structures shown on these plans were obtained by a search of the available records. To the best of our knowledge there are no existing utilities except as shown on these plans. The contractor is required to take precautionary measures to protect the utility lines shown and any other lines not of record or not shown on these plans.
- The private engineer signing these plans is responsible for assuring the accuracy and acceptability of the work hereon. In the event of discrepancies arising during construction, the private engineer shall be responsible for determining an acceptable solution and revising the plans for approval by the City.
- The contractor shall call in a locations request to UNDERGROUND SERVICE ALERT (USA), Phone No. 1-800-422-4133, two working days before digging. No construction permit will be issued by the Public Works Department involving excavation for underground facilities unless the applicant has been provided an Inquiry Identification Number by U.S.A.
- The developer shall be responsible for preserving or re-establishing and referencing survey monuments destroyed, disturbed or buried as a result of construction shown hereon.
- Any traffic control striping obliterated and/or badly worn during construction shall be restored by the contractor within five (5) days after notification from the City Inspector.
- All flagged elevations shall be staked in the field by the private engineer.
- Contractor agrees that he shall assume sole and complete responsibility for job site conditions during the course of construction of this project, including safety of all persons and property; that this requirement shall apply continuously and not be limited to normal working hours; and that the contractor shall defend, indemnify and hold the owner and the engineer harmless from any and all liability, real or alleged, in connection with performance of work on this project, excepting for liability arising from the sole negligence of the owner or the engineer.
- Developer and/or contractor to give R.C.F.C. 5 days written notice prior to starting work on Storm Drain. R.C.F.C. Encroachment Permit No. I-O-220-1591

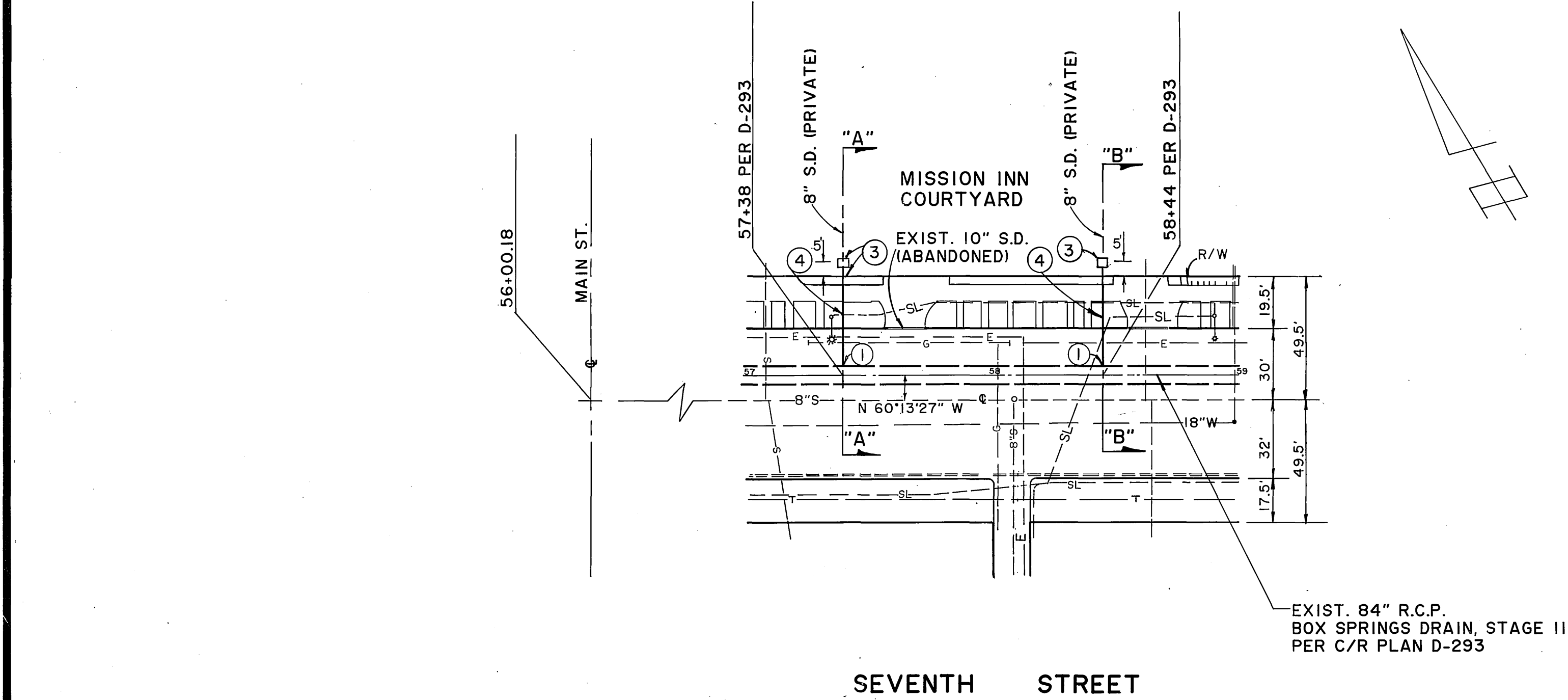
