GENERAL NOTES:

2. IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TO CLEAR THE RIGHT OF WAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF LAW AS IT AFFECTS EACH UTILITY INCLUDING IRRIGATION LINES AND APPURTENANCES AND AT NO COST TO THE CITY.

3. CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, STANDARD DRAWINGS, ITS SUPPLEMENTAL NOTES AND THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION,

4. THE PRIVATE ENGINEER SIGNING THESE PLANS IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ASSURING THE ACCURACY AND ACCEPTABILITY OF THE WORK HEREON. IN THE EVENT OF DISCREPANCIES ARISING DURING CONSTRUCTION, THE PRIVATE ENGINEER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DETERMINING AN ACCEPTABLE SOLUTION AND REVISING THE PLANS FOR APPROVAL BY THE CITY

5. QUANTITIES SHOWN ARE FOR INFORMATION ONLY AND THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR

8. THE DEVELOPER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PRESERVING OR RE-ESTABLISHING AND REFERENCING SURVEY MONUMENTS DESTROYED, DISTURBED OR BURIED AS A RESULT OF CONSTRUCTION SHOWN HEREON.

10. ALL FLAGGED ELEVATIONS SHALL BE STAKED IN THE FIELD BY THE PRIVATE ENGINEER.

11. WHERE NEW PAVEMENT IS TO JOIN THE EXISTING PAVEMENT, THE EDGE OF THE EXISTING PAVEMENT SHALL BE TRIMMED IN A SMOOTH AND STRAIGHT LINE. CONSTRUCT MATCH—UP PAVING AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS AND OVERLAY PAVING AS DIRECTED IN THE FIELD TO PRODUCE A SMOOTH SECTION.

12. CONSTRUCT DRIVEWAY APPROACHES PER STANDARD DRAWING 302. EXACT SIZE AND LOCATION TO BE STAKED BY THE PRIVATE ENGINEER PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION OF THE CURB AND GUTTER.

14. ALL OVERHANGING TREE LIMBS THAT ARE LESS THAN 14' ABOVE THE STREET GRADE SHALL BE TRIMMED BACK.

18. ON ALL AREAS WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY WHERE THE FILL IS ONE (1) FOOT OR GREATER, A LETTER WILL BE REQUIRED FROM THE SOILS ENGINEER, CERTIFYING THE COMPACTION OF THE FILL BELOW SUBGRADE, PRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF THE CONSTRUCTION PERMIT/CUT SHEETS.

20. ALL TRAFFIC SIGNS SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO OPENING THE STREETS TO TRAFFIC.

22. ANY TRAFFIC CONTROL STRIPING OBLITERATED AND/OR BADLY WORN DURING CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE RESTORED BY THE CONTRACTOR WITHIN FIVE DAYS AFTER NOTIFICATION FROM THE CITY INSPECTORS.

23. STREET IMPROVEMENT WORK THAT WILL CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE DETECTOR LOOP(S) SHALL NOT BE PERFORMED UNTIL TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE PERSONNEL HAVE BEEN NOTIFIED AND THE NECESSARY TIMING ADJUSTMENTS ARE MADE TO MAINTAIN SIGNAL OPERATION.

24. FINAL STRIPING FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL AND/OR PAVEMENT MARKING TO BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE DEVELOPER.

25. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL IN A LOCATION REQUEST TO UNDERGROUND SERVICE ALERT (USA), PHONE #
1-800-227-2600, TWO WORKING DAYS BEFORE DIGGING. NO CONSTRUCTION PERMIT WILL BE ISSUED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT INVOLVING EXCAVATION FOR UNDERGROUND FACILITIES UNLESS THE APPLICANT HAS BEEN PROVIDED AN INQUIRY IDENTIFICATION NUMBER BY U.S.A.

35. IN PAVEMENT OVERLAY AREAS, ANY DISTRESSED EXISTING PAVEMENT SHALL BE REMOVED AND REPLACED AS DIRECTED BY THE INSPECTOR PRIOR TO OVERLAYING WITH A.C. PAVING.

PRIVATE ENGINEER'S GENERAL NOTES AND NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR

1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CHECK ALL DRAWINGS AND SPECIFICATIONS FURNISHED HIM IMMEDIATELY UPON THEIR RECEIPT, AND SHALL PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE OWNERS OF ANY DISCREPANCIES HEREIN. SHOULD ANY ERRORS, OMISSIONS, AMBIGUITIES OR DISCREPANCIES BE FOUND ON THE DRAWINGS OR IN THE SPECIFICATIONS TO WHICH THE CONTRACTOR FAILED TO CALL ATTENTION BEFORE SUBMITTING HIS BID, THEN THE OWNERS REPRESENTATIVE WILL INTERPRET THE INTENT OF THE DRAWINGS OR SPECIFICATIONS AND THE CONTRACTOR WILL PERFORM THE WORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUCH INTERPRETATION.

2. ALL CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS PERFORMING WORK SHOWN ON OR RELATED TO THESE PLANS SHALL CONDUCT THEIR OPERATIONS SO THAT ALL EMPLOYEES ARE PROVIDED A SAFE PLACE TO WORK AND THE PUBLIC IS PROTECTED. 4. CONTRACTOR AGREES THAT HE SHALL ASSUME SOLE AND COMPLETE RESPONSIBILITY FOR JOB SITE CONDITIONS DURING THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT, INCLUDING SAFETY OF ALL PERSONS AND PROPERTY; THAT THIS REQUIREMENT SHALL APPLY CONTINUOUSLY AND NOT BE LIMITED TO NORMAL WORKING HOURS; AND THAT THE CONTRACTOR SHALL DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD THE OWNER AND THE ENGINEER HARMLESS FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, REAL OR ALLEGED, IN CONNECTION WITH THE PERFORMANCE OF WORK ON THIS PROJECT, EXCEPTING FOR LIABILITY ARISING FROM THE SOLE NEGLIGENCE OF THE OWNER OR THE ENGINEER.

5. THE CONTRACTOR AND HIS SUBCONTRACTORS SHALL HAVE A VALID CONTRACTORS LICENSE AND MAINTAIN ADEQUATE WORKMAN'S COMPENSATION AS REQUIRED BY THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND ALSO PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE NAMING THE OWNER AS ADDITIONAL INSURED. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUPPLY THE OWNER WITH THESE INSURANCE CERTIFICATES.

6. THE EXISTENCE AND LOCATION OF ANY UNDERGROUND UTILITY PIPES OR STRUCTURES SHOWN ON THIS PLAN ARE OBTAINED BY A SEARCH OF THE AVAILABLE RECORDS. TO THE BEST OF OUR KNOWLEDGE, THERE ARE NO EXISTING UTILITIES EXCEPT AS SHOWN ON THIS PLAN. 
