



NEW CALIFORNIA BUILDING CODES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2023

Please be advised that effective **January 1, 2023**, the City of Riverside Building & Safety Division will begin enforcing the newly adopted 2022 Edition of the California Building Standards Code (Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations) with local amendments for all new permit applications received.

The 2022 California Building Standards Code includes the following twelve parts:

- 2022 California Administrative Code, Part 1
- 2022 California Building Code, Part 2, Volumes 1 and 2
- 2022 California Residential Code, Part 2.5
- 2022 California Electrical Code, Part 3
- 2022 California Mechanical Code, Part 4
- 2022 California Plumbing Code, Part 5
- 2022 California Energy Code, Part 6
- 2022 California Fire Code, Part 9
- 2022 California Existing Building Code, Part 8
- 2022 California Green Building Standards Code, Part 11
- 2022 California Historic Building Code, Part 10
- 2022 California Reference Standards Code, Part 12

Permit applications received on or after January 1, 2023, must be submitted in accordance with the 2022 California Building Codes. Active permit applications **submitted prior to January 1, 2023** shall comply with the previous code in effect at the time of application so long as the permit or plan check does not expire at which time a new permit application shall be submitted in compliance with these requirements.
