

WHAT ELSE ARE YOU DOING ON ELECTION DAY?

On Election Day, over 3,500 Election Officers serve the voters in Riverside County. Your participation in our democratic process is essential in ensuring the on-going success of the electoral process. Please help us in our efforts to make voting in Riverside County an uplifting and rewarding experience for all by volunteering to work at the polls. We are asking those interested in working, to please help us update our records and get to know you a little better.

Our Election Officers tell us that this is a great way to meet new friends and neighbors while serving the community and facilitating the democratic process.

Election Officers in Riverside County receive training before each election at one of dozens of training classes held throughout the county. Each polling place is staffed by 4 Election Officers, 1 Inspector (lead Election Officer) and 3 Precinct Officers, which make up the Precinct Board.

After being trained, the members of each Precinct Board are responsible for setting up the polling place equipment on Election Eve, and for staffing the polling place for the entire Election Day. Duties throughout the day are rotated among the Precinct Board members and include: opening and closing the polls, verifying voter eligibility, providing voters with instructions in voting equipment use, and assisting with the return of ballots and ballot cartridges.

If you are a detail-oriented person who enjoys working with the public, and are able to dedicate the time required for training, Election Eve and Election Day service, we'd like to hear from you. The day is full and challenging, but the smiles given and received, make it all worthwhile.
