Details:

On October 31, 2017 I was working as a uniformed police sergeant with the Riverside Police Department in the City and County of Riverside. I was monitoring the police radio when I heard a radio call of a subject assaulting staff members at Castle View Elementary School located at 6201 Shaker Dr. I responded to the location from the Orange St. station (4102 Orange St.) to assist with the call.

When I arrived Sergeant Lackey was already on scene and coordinating responding officers. I received information that the suspect had entered a classroom in a pod style building. I was directed to building A and classroom A1 and was advised that was the last place the suspect was seen.

I approached building A from the north east part of the school and met with Detective Paes, Officer Newton, Officer Jones, Officer Mowrey and Officer O'Farrell to form an Emergency Response Team (ERT). We positioned ourselves just east of room A1 and approximately 35 yards from the door with a tactical shield and breaching equipment. Eventually Sergeant Angulo responded to our location with a less lethal 40 mm gun. We stayed at the location until the METRO officers were able to respond to the school with an armored vehicle.

Once the METRO officers were in place with the armored vehicle, I moved the ERT team round the south side Building A and into classroom A3. We met with Officer Kerr and Officer Bee in the classroom and relieved them. We held the location as members of the SWAT team began replacing patrol officers.

While holding the classroom, officers were evacuating students and teachers from the campus. I was notified that a teacher and three students were locked in a women's bathroom in a building just west of classroom A3. I took a team of four officers and we were able to evacuate the teacher and students and return to classroom A3. I was later relieved from my position by additional SWAT personnel.
