On 10/31/17, while working as a Police Detective assigned to the West NPC, Partner Detective Cook and I heard radio traffic from a possible kidnap and hostage situation taking place at Castle View Elementary School (6201 Shaker Dr. Riverside Ca 92506). At approximately 1135 hours we began responding to the school in an unmarked unit.

**NARRATIVE:**

Upon our arrival at the school Detective Cook and I took positions on the perimeter at the south east area of the campus. The perimeter area we maintained was closest to the first driveway on the west side of Shaker Dr. north of Century. We held this position for approximately 45 minutes while students were evacuated from campus.

We were then tasked with responding to Castle View Park (The area where evacuated students had been taken) to get [REDACTED] (the suspect's daughter) by Officer B. Moulton and asked to transport her back to the school to meet with Det. Corbett. Upon arrival at Castle View Park I met with Detective Putnam and Assistant Superintendent of Personnel, Kyley Ybarra from Riverside Unified School District who brought [REDACTED] to us for transport back to the school. [REDACTED] and Kyley Ybarra rode with us in our unmarked unit back to Castle View Elementary. Upon arrival, Kyley Ybarra, [REDACTED] and I met with Detective Karla Corbett in the front office area of the school.

After completing that task Det. Cook and I responded back to Castle View Park where we assisted law enforcement personnel, Castle View Elementary and Riverside Unified School District employees with PA announcements and facilitated the safe reunion of students and parents at the park. We assisted in the capacity for nearly two hours before Detective Cook was flagged down by somebody who told me she was Ariana Kelly and her daughter was [REDACTED] and her boyfriend was the suspect at the school. Arianna Kelly said she heard about the incident and was trying to find her daughter. I contacted Sgt. Dan Warren who asked that we bring Ariana Kelly to Castle View Elementary school.

Upon arrival at the school Detective Cook and I briefly interviewed Arianna Kelly who told us she believed S- Kennon was having some type of mental episode and that his actions were totally out of character. She said everything was normal between her and S- Kennon when she left work and had no idea what caused or why S- Kennon was at the school trying to remove their daughter from school. Arianna Kelly told Detective Cook and I that S- Kennon had called and left a voicemail on her phone during the morning and asked if we wanted to hear it. We said "yes" and she put her phone on speaker before starting the voicemail. The voicemail started and I could hear a brief second or two of muffled, distorted unrecognizable noise before being able to hear what I believed to be a female voice scream. Mid scream, Arianna Kelly's phone battery died and the phone powered off. She tried multiple times to turn the phone back on without success. Ariana Kelly's phone was an "Android" type and we did not have charging cable to power the phone back on.

Shortly after, Det. Corbett came out to our unmarked unit and sat in the back seat with Ariana Kelly and interviewed her. (See Det. Corbett's report for details.) Following her interview Det. Corbett went back inside the school and left Ariana Kelly with Detective Cook and me in the car. Det. Corbett went back and forth between the school and my car several more times.

The police radio was on in our car and Ariana Kelly was able to overhear police traffic related to S- Kennon and the incident. After being seated in the back seat for nearly an hour Ariana Kelly was able to power her phone on and call S- Kennon (without being told or asked to do so) and he answered the phone before her phone lost power and turned off again.

I relayed this information to Det. Corbett who was able to locate an "Android" phone charger and brought it to Ariana Kelly and asked permission to take her phone in an attempt to communicate with S- Kennon. Ariana Kelly allowed Det. Corbett to take her phone. Det. Corbett left Ariana Kelly in the back seat of my car and went back into the school with her (Kelly's) phone. A while later Det. Corbett came back to the car and got Ariana Kelly and took her into the office with her.

Around 1715 hours Detective Cook and I were relieved from Castle View Elementary and we cleared the scene for EOW.
