No On 10-31-17, about 1120 hours, I was working in the Lincoln Station range when I heard a radio call at Castle View Elementary School (6201 Shaker) involving a battery and possible hostage barricade. I responded to the location with Lt. Hutzler to assist, based on the nature of the call. Upon arrival I took a long rifle position in the cafeteria approximately 30 yards N/of the A building (where the suspect was last seen dragging the hostage. I was relieved from that position once the sniper element was set in place (approximately 1.5 hours). I responded to the command post to see if I could assist in some capacity. The ENT team did not have a team member to work as a liaison with the suspects family so I stayed in a room with them until Officer Quillen relieved me (approximately 1 hour). I asked Lt. 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in room A3. I responded to room A3 to assist Officer Hill and the Corona officer in an interior perimeter capacity. I maintained my position in room A3 (for approximately 3 hours) until the divert command was given and the entry team began to breach the accordion door.

One of the SWAT operators, later identified as Sgt. Ortiz was attempting to breach a door from the common room in the A building. We saw he did not have lethal cover and moved in to assist in that capacity. I heard several gunshots a pause and several more gunshots. Sgt. Ortiz was unable to breach the door due to objects blocking the opposite side. I heard via police radio the suspect was down and saw the entry team escort V-1 from the A building.

I transported Detective Paes to the Magnolia Station after speaking with Sgt. Warren and waited with Det. Paes until the investigators arrived at the Magnolia Station.

My weapons were charted by Detectives D. Smith, Corbett, and G. Anderson. I did not interview any witnesses or collect any evidence.
