Narrative:

On 10/31/17, I was assigned as a Detective to the East Neighborhood Policing Center and collaterally assigned to the Technical Services Unit for the Riverside Police Department. At about 1120 hours, I heard Dispatch broadcast an incident at the Castle View Elementary School, which is located at 6201 Shaker Drive, Riverside CA 92506. I responded to the scene and assisted with perimeter containment duties by maintaining visual observation on the south side of the school, just south of the main office building until I was relieved of this duty.

I was reassigned to assist with evacuating children from the school grounds and walking them to awaiting buses on Shaker Drive and Century Avenue. The buses transported the children to Castle View Park. After the children were evacuated, I responded to Castle View Park and assisted by contacting homeowners on Glen Aire Avenue to see if they would permit the use of their bathroom for children who needed to go to the bathroom. I escorted children and their teachers to the houses on Glen Aire Avenue so they could use the bathroom.

Based on the information provided, the suspect had two backpacks with him and the initial responding officers observed smoke coming from the classroom. At about 1416 hours, I responded to the Technical Services Unit bomb truck to assist. I am a FBI certified bomb technician and have been trained for safe and effective bomb disposal and handling a wide range of explosive, chemical, biological, and nuclear devices. At about 1804 hours, after the suspect and hostage were out of the classroom, TSU Personnel and I conducted a safety sweep of the classroom. We X-rayed and manually searched the bags inside the room. We determined there were no explosives or hazardous materials present in the bags.

At about 1900 hours, I cleared the scene.
