<p>On 2/20/2017 I was working as a uniformed Watch C Supervisor for the Riverside Police Department. At about 2253 hours, I heard Officers working 3R40 put out radio traffic of "3R40, shots fired". The officers identified their location and that a suspect fled armed with a firearm. I responded to the scene driving marked black and white police unit #3542. I drove in to the location eastbound Garfield to northbound MacArthur. Upon arriving, I saw a female lying prone in the street just south of 4041 MacArthur. There was a vehicle parked on the east curb line with two occupants in the front seats. Officers were calling the female back to them and took her into custody. I located Officers Carmona and Espinoza who were not injured. I assisted Sergeant Warren with coordinating a high-risk stop on occupants inside the vehicle.</p> <p>I took a public safety statement from officer Carmona. He told me he fired approximately 10 rounds in an easterly direction. He stated there was one subject outstanding that fled in an easterly direction who was</p> <p>1. I then coordinated officers to provide a protective perimeter around the scene in case the suspect was still nearby. Sergeant Warren and Sergeant McCoy coordinated search teams along the route the suspect fled. Once the immediate area was secure, I gathered information to give a briefing to Lieutenant Hoxmeier who was the Watch Commander.

A SWAT call-out was initiated. Once SWAT personnel arrived, I briefed SWAT Sergeant Corbett on the known circumstances. I stayed at the command post which was at the corner of Garfield and MacArthur. I assisted with coordinating developing information inside of the mobile command post. I continued in this capacity until approximately 1200 hours on 02-21-2017 when I was released from the scene.
