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Narrative:

On 02-20-17 at about 2342 hours, I received notification from the Riverside Police Department's Dispatch Center that a full SWAT call-out had been initiated. The notification from RPD's Dispatch Center advised SWAT personnel to respond to the area of Van Buren/Garfield, in the city of Riverside, reference an officer involved shooting incident.

02-21-17 at about 0030 hours, I arrived at the Command Post, which was designated at MacArthur/Garfield. At the Command Post, I received further details from Sgt. Corbett regarding the incident and learned that an armed suspect fled the scene on foot following the officer involved shooting. The suspect was possibly wounded during the exchange of gun fire. Responding patrol personnel was able to locate a blood trail leading them to the driveway of [REDACTED]. A perimeter was established around that location. At the time, the suspect was not named and described as a Hispanic male adult, approximately 40 years of age, and heavy set with facial hair.

As a member of the SWAT Team, I was assigned to a search team utilizing the Armored Rescue Vehicle (ARV). That designated search team comprised of Sgt. Corbett, Officer D. Smith, Officer Monreal, Officer S. Macias, Officer Soria, Officer Wright, Officer Allison, Officer Mercadefe, Officer Glover, K-9 Officer Larkin and I.

Our objective for the search team was to conduct a yard to yard search beginning at [REDACTED] and locate/apprehend the suspect. Prior to the search, our initial plan was to evacuate the residents occupying the west structure on the property [REDACTED]. Due to the nature of the crime and the potential for S/Garcia being armed, we utilized ballistic shields for this portion of the operation. I was designated to hold a ballistic shield and provide cover for the search team as they made contact with the residents inside [REDACTED]. They were successfully evacuated from the property and moved to a safe location, where patrol officers were staged. We did not locate the suspect on the west portion of the property.

As [REDACTED] was being evacuated and cleared, search team members observed several subjects in the rear yard of [REDACTED]. At this point, the ARV was summoned to the driveway to provide cover for operators as they made contact with the residents of the east structure. All but one of the subjects complied, as a heavy set Hispanic male walked back into the residence. I made contact with one of the four subjects (O/[REDACTED]) that complied and conducted an interview with her.

O/Lopez told me that she lives at [REDACTED] with several others. O/[REDACTED] said on 02-20-17 at about 2300 hours, a Hispanic male subject came walking into her residence holding a semi-automatic handgun. She told me that the subject appeared to be bleeding from one of his legs. O/[REDACTED] was adamant that she did not know the subject. She described him as a Hispanic male adult, approximately 40 years of age, heavy set with a bald head. O/[REDACTED] said the subject had a thick mustache and was wearing dark colored shorts and T-shirt. O/[REDACTED] said when they were exiting the house, the subject was standing in the kitchen area towards the wash room. She provided a description of the interior of the house and a layout of the residence. She told me nobody else was inside the residence. O/[REDACTED] was handed off to patrol personnel and later interviewed by Det. Dave Smith.

Based on observations by the search team and the information provided by O/[REDACTED] the search team transitioned to the Emergency Response Team (ERT) utilizing the ARV. As a part of the ERT, I rotated with other operators as lethal cover from the passenger side of the ARV for the next several hours.

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Narrative continued:

I relayed the information from O [REDACTED] to Sgt. Corbett, who broadcasted the information to all SWAT personnel. Through interviews with the occupants of the residence, the suspect was identified as S/Garcia.

At about 0547 hours, a throw phone mission was planned and put into effect. I was assigned to carry a ballistic shield and provide ballistic protection for operators on the throw phone team. After successfully deploying the throw phone through the upstairs attic window at about 0547 hours, the team moved back to the ARV.

At the ARV, I continued to rotate positions with other operators and held lethal cover on the residence from the passenger side of the ARV. At about 0630 hours, Officer Soria briefed me on my roles and responsibilities for the chemical agents mission. I was tasked with holding the shield and providing ballistic protection for a team of operators as chemical agents were deployed into the northwest corner window of [REDACTED]. At approximately 0703 hours, I moved up with a team of operators while holding a shield and provided ballistic protection as they successfully deployed chemical agents into the northwest corner window of the residence. After the chemical agent deployment, the team moved back to west side of the [REDACTED] and took cover behind a block wall.

Some time after the gas mission, I observed dark smoke coming from the roof on the east side of [REDACTED]. The residence eventually caught on fire.

As a result, I moved back to the ARV and rotated with other operators in trying to put out the fire and prevent other structures from catching fire. We utilized a water charged fire hose in trying to put out the fire until Riverside Fire Department personnel relieved us. Once relieved by RFD personnel, I took a position next to RFD personnel as force protection.

The suspect was later found deceased in the bathroom on the north side of [REDACTED]. I cleared the scene on 02-21-17 at about 1200 hours.
