62. Narrative of Supplemental Report, 62a. Audio Recording Available? No, 62b. Incident Number: Narrative: On 02/20/17, at approximately 2351 hours, I was at home and was off-duty. At that time, I received a text from dispatch informing me that there was a full SWAT call-out and we were to meet up on Garfield West of MacArthur. Since I am a member of the Collateral SWAT team (white team) I changed into my SWAT uniform and I responded to RPD Lincoln Station to retrieve all my SWAT gear. Once I had my gear, I responded to the command post which was located on Garfield, near MacArthur. I arrived on scene at the command post at approximately 0100 hours. I was the scribe for Sgt. Reeves for a bit. I was asked to drive the SWAT equipment truck closer to the scene at [redacted] from the command post. I drove the equipment truck and parked it on MacArthur just North of Sage. Officer Payne and I were asked to relieve Officer Allison who was assigned to the 1/4 corner of [redacted] (a perimeter spot). We grabbed a ladder from the equipment truck and responded to that location. We relieved Officer Allison. Officer Payne and I

took a position in the side yard to [REDACTED] That yard was located just South of [REDACTED] We were positioned just South of the cinder block wall which separated the properties of [REDACTED] The wall was approximately six feet in height, and ran East to West. Officer Payne and I were located approximately fifty feet from the 1/4 corner of [REDACTED] We had a good view of the 1 and 4 sides to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] from our position. One of us stood on the ladder, while the other one stood on a large wooden spool (used to keep wiring) which we located inside the yard to [REDACTED] We both kept a visual of the house as we had our long guns pointed towards the open garage door to [REDACTED] The open garage door was located on the 4 side of the house, near the 1/4 corner. When gas was introduced inside [REDACTED] we had a good view of the gas team which approached the 3/4 side of the house. The burn-safe was deployed inside [REDACTED] through a window which was located on the 3/4 corner of the house. A fire started right after the burn-safe was deployed. An operator broadcasted over the radio that the house was on fire. The fire quickly spread along the 4 side of the house. We maintained our position through-out the rest of the operation in case S1/Garcia exited the open garage door of [REDACTED] No one exited the house. We heard what sounded like a gunshot coming from inside of [REDACTED] Right after I heard what sounded like a gunshot, several operators broadcasted over the radio that they had heard a gunshot coming from inside the residence. The fire consumed a large portion of the house. Officer Payne and I remained in our assigned location until we were told we could clear by Sgt. Corbett. We were told we could clear at approximately 1030 hours. For further information see the initial report for this incident and the other numerous supplemental reports.
