**Background:**

The suspect was wanted for attempt murder on a police officer, still outstanding, and armed with an unknown type handgun.

**Source:**

On Monday, February 20<sup>th</sup> 2017 at approximately 2253 hours, I responded to the area of McArthur Rd. and California Ave. reference an officer involved shooting.

**Details:**

Upon arrival at McArthur Rd. and California Ave. there were sufficient units at that location to handle a felony vehicle stop on the vehicle related to the officer involved shooting. Supervision and dispatch were asking for units to establish a perimeter around the area and I drove to mid-block Van Buren Blvd. north of Garfield St. and established an outer perimeter position facing east. I maintained this position until approximately 0300 hours, when I was requested to respond to the area of McArthur Rd. and Sage Ave. for a new assignment.

Once at McArthur Rd. and Sage Ave. I was ordered to partner up with Officer Reeves as a swat element and the two of us went to the backyard of [REDACTED] to relieve other Metro officers in a containment position. Officer Reeves and I assumed the responsibility of containment #1 from the rear yard of [REDACTED] We made an elevated position behind the residences north wall and had clear view of the #1 side and #4 side of [REDACTED] We had a clear view of the garage and inside the garage at [REDACTED] which was lit up by the garages interior light.

During my observations, at approximately 0703 hours, I observed four Metro officers, approach the residence towards the three four corner and deploy a "burn safe" for a chemical agent mission into a window on the #3 side of the residence. As the officers backed away from the residence after deploying the burn safe I observed a fire in the same area where I saw the "burn safe" deployed. I observed the fire approximately one minute after the "burn safe" was deployed.

We maintained visual and physical containment on both the #1 side and #4 side of [REDACTED] for the duration of the incident and were released from our position at approximately 1130 hours.
