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1 **NARRATIVE**

2
3 On 07/20/18, at approximately 2030 hours, I was notified by Sergeant Crawford of an officer
4 involved shooting that occurred at Arlington Ave. / Streeter Ave. He requested I respond to the
5 command post located in the Hardman Center (5100-5200 block of Arlington Ave.) to assist with
6 the investigation. I arrived at the command post at approximately 2130 hours. After the initial
7 brief, given by Sergeant Elliott, I was assigned to interview witnesses.

8
9 I obtained one witness statement from Morales, Manuel (covered in a separate supplemental
10 report).

11
12 During this time, a homicide (unrelated) at another location occurred. Duties were reassigned, and
13 I was tasked to assist Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis with processing the crime scene.

14
15 Members of Riverside Police Department's Traffic Unit were also called out to assist. Officer
16 Leyva (certified operator) utilized the FARO 3D Laser Scanner (Model S-350) to document the
17 scene (see his supplemental report).

18
19 **SCENE DESCRIPTION**

20
21 The scene was located in eastbound lanes of traffic on Arlington Ave., east of Streeter Ave. It also
22 included a lane of traffic for motorists turning eastbound onto Arlington Ave., from California Ave.
23 This lane of traffic runs in northeast direction, and is directly north of Del Taco located at [REDACTED]

SCENE PROCESSING / EVIDENCE COLLECTED

Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis and I processed the scene to include locating, documenting, photographing, and collecting evidence. Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis took video and overall photographs of the crime scene, prior to evidence collection. She and I both created sketches of the crime scene.

We located three expended cartridge cases in the following locations: the asphalt north of Unit #3135 (CM01); the front passenger floorboard of Unit #3135 (CM02); driver side roof of a Toyota Camry [REDACTED] (CM03).

Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis and I located possible blood on the front driver side bumper of a Toyota Camry [REDACTED] (CM04) and possible blood on the asphalt below the same vehicle on the driver side (CM05).

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1 We located a set of keys (CM06) with an attached vehicle remote key from the driver side roof of
2 the suspect's vehicle; a 2012 silver Chrysler 200 (CA Plate 7JPW282).

3
4 **Charting of Officer Reimer's Weapon**

5
6 At 0350 hours, Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis and I charted Officer Reimer's rifle which had
7 been secured in the trunk of Unit #3823. The weapon was rendered safe by Evidence Specialist
8 McKay-Davis and was determined to be a Smith & Wesson, Model M&P-15, 5.56 caliber, Serial #
9 SU21910. The thirty (30) round capacity magazine in her weapon was loaded with twenty-nine
10 (29) live rounds and a live round was in the chamber for a total of thirty (30) rounds. The weapon
11 was released to Sergeant Munoz at 0414 hours.

12
13 **Processing of Suspect Levario, Arthur (S1/Levario)**

14
15 The driver of the suspect vehicle, identified as S1/Levario, was in the driver seat and slumped over
16 to the right. There was a black semi-auto handgun on the front passenger seat of the vehicle, next
17 to his right arm.

18
19 Deputy Coroners Devore and Bengtson conducted a preliminary death investigation of the
20 suspect. The preliminary investigation showed injuries consistent with a gunshot wound(s) to
21 S1/Levario's head/neck.

22
23 S1/Levario was clothed in a grey T-shirt, blue denim shorts with a black belt, red/white/blue/black
24 plaid boxers; he wore blue Sketcher tennis shoes and white socks.

25
26 Deputy Coroner Devore located and recovered the following items from the pockets of
27 S1/Lavario's shorts: pair of black rubber and grey cloth gloves (ACL01), black wallet (ACL02), clear
28 and blue plastic lighter (ACL03), "Northwest Trail" folding knife (found unfolded)(ACL04), blue and
white bandana (ACL05), and a piece of clear plastic attached to blue/white paper (ACL06).

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1 Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis took possession of these items (see her report for further details
2 to include location from which items were recovered).

3
4 It should be noted Deputy Coroner Devore located and maintained custody of S1/Levario's
5 California Identification Card [REDACTED] which was found inside the black wallet.

6
7 Deputy Coroner Devore also performed a gunshot residue (GSR) test (ACL07) on S1/Levario's
8 hands and collected fingernail clippings (ACL08) from the same. Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis
9 took possession of these items.

10 *ACL = Arthur Cornejo Levario

11
12 S1/Levario's body was transported to the Riverside County Sheriff Coroner's Office by transport
13 personnel (Hammonds).

14
15 **Charting of Suspect Weapon**

16
17 Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis and I located a weapon (CM07) on the front passenger seat of
18 the suspect's vehicle. Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis photographed the weapon as it was
19 found, and then just outside the vehicle where she and I charted it at 1007 hours (07/21/18).

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1 The weapon (CM07) was a "HI-POINT" .40 caliber semi-auto pistol, Model JCP, Serial #7183128
2 or #71B3128, and had a double feed; it also had possible blood on it. The chamber contained a
3 "WIN 40 S&W" fired cartridge case and a "WIN 40 S&W" live round. The magazine in the weapon
4 was loaded with five (5) "WIN 40 S&W" live rounds.

9 It should be noted Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis was unable to render the weapon safe and
10 asked me to assist her. I released the magazine and pulled back on the slide a couple times in an
11 attempt to release the fired cartridge case and live round. The live round ejected, but the fired
12 cartridge case remained stuck. I handed the weapon back to Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis;
13 she pulled back on the slide a few more times and the fired cartridge case ejected. This process
14 took more handling of the weapon than anticipated.
15

16 **Towing of Suspect Vehicle**
17

18 We completed processing the scene on 07/21/18 at 1142 hours and had the suspect vehicle (silver
19 2012 Chrysler 200, CA Plate 7JPW282) towed to the Magnolia Station for processing. The vehicle
20 was towed by Victoria Towing and Evidence Specialist McKay-Davis and I followed. The vehicle
21 was placed in a secure evidence bay and released from the tow driver at 1207 hours (see attached
22 CHP 180). It should be noted the tow driver loaded the vehicle onto his truck at 1050 hours, and

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- 1 stayed at the scene until we finished clearing the remaining vehicles (which belonged to witnesses
- 2 or uninvolved parties – see Officer Montero’s report).



On 07/20/18, at approximately 2030 hours, I was notified by Sergeant Crawford of an officer involved shooting that occurred at Arlington Ave. / Streeter Ave. He requested I respond to the command post located in the Hardman Center (5100-5200 block of Arlington Ave.) to assist with the investigation. I arrived at the command post at approximately 2130 hours. After the initial briefing, given by Sergeant Elliott, I was assigned to interview witnesses and assist in processing the scene.

I later requested this file (P18135895) to document the vehicles in the scene in the event any insurance claims may be filed.

It was determined a silver, 2012, Chrysler 200, CA PLT 7JPW282, traveled westbound on Arlington Ave. in eastbound lanes of traffic at Arlington Ave. / Streeter Ave. This caused several vehicles to swerve out of the way.


