62. Narrative of Supplemental Report

On 7/20/2018, at approximately 2035 hours, I received a phone request from Sergeant M. Crawford to process the scene of an officer involved shooting. At approximately 2133 hours, I arrived at the shopping center parking lot east of California Avenue and Arlington Avenue. I contacted Detectives K. Beler and K. Corbett. Senior Forensic Specialist R. Meyer and Volunteer Robert Fredrick #9071 reported to the scene to assist processing. Volunteer Fredrick and I received an incident brief from Sergeant P. Elliot and participated in the walk-through. At the request of Detective Beler, I directed Senior Forensic Specialist R. Meyer take photographs of a Hemet Police Department vehicle within the scene. Refer to her supplemental report. Volunteer Fredrick was reassigned to assist processing a homicide and cleared the scene.

I completed a digital video recording of the scene (Evidence Item #CM08). I took digital photographs of the scene, suspect, vehicles in the area, and evidence collected. Photography and processing was extended due to concurrent FARO scanning of the scene with the Major Accident Investigation Team (MAIT).

On 7/21/2018, I removed, photographed, and charted a "Smith & Wesson" model M&P-15 rifle, 5.56 caliber, serial # SU32910, from the trunk of RPD Unit #3823. At approximately 0414 hours, I released the weapon to Sergeant J. Munoz. I placed evidence markers and photographed Evidence Items #CM01-CM07 and possible Strike Marks "A" to "I". From approximately 0541-0709 hours, I reported to the Magnolia Station while the final FARO scene scans were completed. I reproduced a master DVD of the scene digital video recording (Item #CM08) and a copy of the digital video recording (Evidence Item #CM08-A). I secured the digital video recordings and reported to the scene. After the completion of the last FARO scans, I completed processing the scene. I collected Evidence Items #CM01-CM06 and CM09.

fingernail clippings (Evidence Item #ACL08). At approximately 0926 hours, I released the S/Levario's California Identification Card to Deputy Coroner Devore.

I collected and charted Evidence Item #CM07, assisted by Detective K. Corbett. For processing purposes, I separated Item #CM07 into Items #CM07, and CM07-A through CM07-C. I processed the scene assisted and directed by Detective K. Corbett. Refer to the Evidence Logs and Weapon Charting Forms. At approximately 1142 hours, I cleared the scene and followed the suspect vehicle to the Magnolia Station. At approximately 1207 hours, I secured the vehicle in the Magnolia Station Evidence Bay, and all evidence items in the evidence vault. Refer to the Evidence Log, Vehicle Evidence Log, Weapon Charting Forms, and California Highway Patrol 180 Vehicle Report. Evidence item measurements will be included in the FARO scene scan. I downloaded a total of (725) digital photographs to a secure file format in the Digital Information Management System (DIMS).

On 7/22/2018, I downloaded the digital scene video recording to DIMS.

On 7/24/18, I removed all evidence items from the evidence vault for processing. I took (14) digital photographs of the Items #ACL01 and ACL02. For processing purposes, I separated Item #ACL04 into Items #ACL04 and ACL04-A. Refer to the Evidence Log. I secured all evidence items and digital photograph card in the evidence vault after processing. Later that day, I downloaded the digital photographs to a secure file format.

On 7/26/18, at approximately 1118 hours, I released Items #CM01-CM03 to Magnolia Station Police Property Specialist C. Sanchez for transportation to the crime lab. From approximately 1425-1520 hours, I took (42) digital photographs of RPD Unit #3135 and possible Strike Marks "A" to "F" (RPD Unit #3135 and Chrysler 200). On 8/16/2018, I received a request from Detective K. Beler to conduct a latent print search on Evidence Item #CM07: "HI-POINT", 40 CALIBER PISTOL SEMI-AUTO MODEL JCP BBL 4 3-4 SERIAL #X 7183128 (BLACK)". On 8/30/18, at approximately 1621 hours, I checked out Item #CM07 from Magnolia Station Police Property Specialist C. Sepulveda, and secured the item in my locked evidence cabinet.

On 8/31/2018, I received phone authorization to also conduct a latent print search on the magazine of Evidence Item #CM07-B: "(1) MAGAZINE (POSSIBLE BLOOD) & (5) 'WIN 40 S&W'". At approximately 0926 hours, I checked out Item #CM07-B from Magnolia Station Police Program Supervisor S. King. I removed Item #CM07 from my locked evidence cabinet. I began a latent print search on Items #CM07 and CM07-B using cyanoacrylate fumes. I secured Items #CM07 and CM07-B in my locked evidence cabinet and removed them later that afternoon. I conducted a preemptive check for background fluorescence on the items using a SPEX Mini-CrimeScope forensic light source. Excessive background fluorescence was not detected on the items. I further conducted a latent print search on Items #CM07 and CM07-B by applying

rhodamine 6G dye stain with a distilled water rinse. I secured the items in a drying chamber to allow them to dry completely.

On 9/4/2018, I removed Items #CM07 and CM07-B from the drying chamber. I conducted a search for latent prints on the items using a high intensity white light and the forensic light source (455nm, CSS, 515nm, 535nm, 555nm with red and orange filters). I identified (2) latent print areas that required photographic documentation on Item #CM07. I photographed Latent Print Area #1 using the forensic light source (515nm with orange filter; 535nm with red filter) and high intensity white light. I photographed Latent Print Area #2 using the forensic light source (515nm with orange filter) and high intensity white light. I secured Items #CM07 and CM07-B in my locked evidence cabinet. I downloaded a total of (36) digital photographs to a secure file format in the Digital Information Management System (DIMS).

On 9/11/18, I reproduced (8) 1:1 ratio latent print photograph cards for Latent Print Areas #1 and 2, and a CD with the images (Evidence Item #CM07-D). Refer to the Latent Print Notes and Property Report. I secured the item in my locked evidence cabinet.

On 9/12/18, at approximately 1551 hours, I released Item #CM07-D to Riverside Cal-ID for analysis.

On 9/13/18, at approximately 1240 hours, I released Items #CM07 and CM07-B to Magnolia Station Property Locker #29.

On 9/14/18, I downloaded the (8) 1:1 ratio photographs to DIMS. No further action was taken.
