OBSERVATIONS:

I observed the autopsy from inside the observation room. Forensic Evidence Specialist J. Greer was in the examination room. Levario was on the exam table in a sealed white body bag. The seal on Levario's body bag was broken at 1115 hours. Levario was clothed in a grey T-shirt, blue denim shorts with a black belt, and red/white/blue/black plaid boxers; a pair of blue Sketcher tennis shoes and white socks lay at his feet.

Tattoos

Levario had a tattoo on his upper chest, just below his neck. The tattoo read, "En Memoria De Mi Carnal".

Injuries

Dr. Rodriguez conducted the external examination. I noted the following injuries on Levario: multiple small wounds on the back of the head (predominately the left side), a large wound on the left side of his neck (at base of skull, just below and behind left ear), multiple small wounds on the back side of left shoulder, a postmortem wound on the top of his left shoulder, and multiple postmortem wounds on the left side of his upper torso (see photos for details).

Dr. Rodriguez then conducted the internal examination. She was unable to determine entrance/exits wounds due to the number of wounds caused from bullet and glass fragments. She did indicate Levario's skull was fractured in multiple places and his spinal cord was severed;

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these injuries appeared to be related to the large wound on the left side of his neck (see photos for details).

ITEMS COLLECTED:

I observed the listed items being collected by Forensic Evidence Specialist J. Greer (see her Supplemental Report for complete details on all the evidence collected and photographs taken during the autopsy):

- Blood sample
- Buccal swab
- All clothing
- Bullet fragments (copper and silver colored metal)

CONCLUSION:

The autopsy concluded at 1338 hours. The COD (Cause of Death) was listed as: Pending Coroner Review. Refer to Autopsy Protocol for complete details.
