Narrative of Supplemental Report On 07-20-18 at about 1953 hours, I was dispatched to assist in a vehicle pursuit where officers from a nearby agency were taking gunfire from an occupant inside the pursued vehicle. The vehicle pursuit was travelling northbound on the 215 freeway towards the City of Riverside. I responded from the area of Blaine and the 215 Freeway and began to drive towards the location. The pursuit changed direction and got onto City surface streets onto Van Buren Blvd. from the 215 Freeway.  During the pursuit it was requested that outside police agencies discontinue their pursuit so that Riverside PD take it over. I acquired the pursuit on Victoria Av. near Jackson St. I stayed behind and was about 7 cars behind the pursued vehicle and awaiting outside agency to get out of the pursuit. Once the pursuit went into a residential neighborhood near Palomar and Arlington, I was too far behind to continue and the other agencies were not abandoning their pursuit so I discontinued trying to join the pursuit.	62a. 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I arrived at the termination of the vehicle pursuit a few seconds after it concluded. The suspect vehicle was blocked from my sight by other police vehicles. As I approached the suspect vehicle, I was tasked by Sergeant Elliot to be Officer O'Farrell's companion officer. I stayed with Officer O'Farrell until I was replaced by Officer Maier.

Sergeant Munoz tasked me with getting the identifying information of two potential witnesses to the officer shooting. Officer Hernandez took me to O [REDACTED] and O [REDACTED]. They both told me they were in a tan colored Toyota Camry that was adjacent to the suspect's vehicle. [REDACTED] stated she was the driver and [REDACTED] was the front passenger. I obtained their identifying information and told them to stay at the scene for a further interview by a detective.

Sergeant D. Smith advised me to stay with Officer Hernandez until he could be met by a detective. I stayed with Officer Hernandez until 2325 hours when I was released from the scene by Sergeant Simmons.
