12 The incident was recorded via my department issued body worn camera and downloaded under the  
13 given file number (P18-135608).

15 **Narrative:**

16 On 07-20-18, at approximately 1946 hours, partner Officer Carmona and I were working full  
17 uniformed patrol for the City of Riverside Police Department. Dispatch broadcasted over Channel 1 that  
18 a pursuit was entering the City of Riverside. Dispatch further advised that an occupant of the vehicle had  
19 already shot at pursuing Riverside County Sheriff Deputies. Officer Carmona and I monitored the pursuit  
20 via the radio, while the pursuit traversed the streets of Riverside. While monitoring the radio, Officers  
21 advised that the vehicle had crashed into oncoming traffic on Arlington Avenue, just east of Streeter  
22 Avenue (on the east bound lanes of Arlington). Shortly thereafter, "Shots Fired" was broadcasted over  
23 the radio.

25 **Investigative Actions:**

26 Officer Carmona and I responded to the area and saw that Officers had begun to setup for a "High  
27 Risk" felony stop. Officer Carmona positioned our vehicle at an angle on the westbound lanes of  
28 Arlington (north/east) of the suspect vehicle. I exited the passenger side of our unit and held lethal cover  
29 on the passenger side of the suspect vehicle (grey Chrysler 200 convertible). Air 1 broadcasted over the  
30 radio that the suspect was slumped over the passenger seat in the vehicle and not moving. From my  
31 position I could not see the suspect, but I could see the rear passenger window was shattered and the front  
32 passenger window was rolled down. Multiple announcements were made to the suspect with no response.

34 Upon the arrival of the Armored Rescue Vehicle (ARV), I was relieved of my position by Sergeant D.  
35 Smith. I responded to the rear of the ARV, where a tactical plan was formulated to make contact with the  
36 suspect and take him into custody. The METRO Team entered the ARV and approached the suspect  
37 vehicle, where Officers could visually see the suspect (See Officer Newton's supplemental report for  
38 details). Officer Soria deployed a less lethal shotgun at the suspect to illicit a response (See Officer  
39 Soria's supplemental report for details), which was met with negative results. Officer Feimer deployed  
40 his K-9 on the suspect to illicit a response (See Officer Feimer's supplemental report for details), which  
41 was met with negative results.

43 Upon Sergeant Dehdashtian's command, I exited the rear of the ARV and approached the suspect  
44 vehicle along the driver's door. I could see an unresponsive suspect in the driver's seat, slumped over  
45 onto the passenger seat. I then transitioned to the trunk and assisted Officer Wright with clearing the

- 1 trunk of the vehicle. Once the vehicle was rendered safe, I transitioned to placing crime scene tape up
- 2 along the south side curb line of Arlington Avenue to Streeter. Per Sergeant Elliott's request, I turned off
- 3 all the civilian vehicles along the eastbound lanes of Arlington Avenue (leaving the keys in the ignition).
- 4 I then conducted scene security before being relieved by Sergeant Dehdashtian. NFI.
