



Notification and Response:

On 07/22/18 at approximately 1245 hours, I was assigned as a day shift patrol supervisor. I was in full police uniform and assigned to supervise the east end of the city. I monitored radio traffic as Officer K. Gutierrez and Officer J. Cuevas were dispatched to the McDonalds at 2242 University Avenue in the city and county of Riverside regarding a battery in progress. Dispatch advised that a B/M transient approximately 30 years old was assaulting McDonald's customers and employees inside the restaurant. The last updated information dispatched was that employees and customers now had the suspect restrained on the ground. I drove over to the location to assist the officers who were dispatched to the call.

Officer Cuevas arrived on scene first. After approximately one minute I heard Officer Cuevas on the radio request medical aid for a breathing but non responsive subject. I arrived on scene within 3-4 minutes and at about the same time as Officer Gutierrez. Upon my arrival, I observed the suspect later identified as David Russell lying on the tile floor behind the service counter of McDonalds. He was lying on the employee's side where there is typically no customer access. He was laying on his left side with his hands placed in handcuffs behind his back. Officer Cuevas was kneeling behind Russell holding him onto his left side. Russell was breathing, he was slightly moving his mouth, his hands and his feet but he wasn't communicating verbally. Officer Cuevas was rubbing Russell's sternum with his fingers in an attempt to get him to respond and/or communicate. Russell appeared to respond to the stimulation by slightly grimacing but he remained non-responsive.

American Medical Response (AMR) arrived within a few minutes. They requested that we carry Russell out from the small crowded space behind the counter and bring him outside to their gurney. Officer Cuevas and I grabbed Russell by both of his shoulders. He was still breathing but he was non-responsive. We carried him outside with the assistance of AMR and we placed Russell on the gurney. Officer Cuevas removed the handcuffs from Russell's hands. Russell was loaded onto the gurney positioned on his back and then he was placed into the ambulance. Russell's hands were then restrained to the gurney using AMR's soft restraints for transportation to the hospital.

Officer Gutierrez interviewed [REDACTED] who was a customer and a victim assaulted by Russell. Garcia ultimately helped restrain Russell to prevent him during his rage rom assaulting employees and other customers. [REDACTED] applied a "Carotid" hold to Russell's neck from behind. Refer to Officer Gutierrez' report containing [REDACTED]'s recorded statement. Officer Gutierrez also spoke to two additional victims who were assaulted by Russell. By the end of the investigation, Officer Gutierrez determined that none of the three victims were injured. None of the three desired prosecution nor would they sign a Private Person's Arrest against Russell for the assault.

AMR was getting ready to transport Russell to Riverside Community Hospital for medical treatment. When I last observed Russell he was still non-responsive but breathing. I

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instructed Officer Cuevas to drive to Riverside Community Hospital and meet AMR and then update me from the hospital. After approximately 20 minutes I contacted Officer Cuevas who advised me that AMR still had not arrived at the hospital. Officer Cuevas left the hospital to back another officer on an in progress domestic violence call that was just dispatched. I contacted our dispatch center and asked them to call AMR and find out if the ambulance might have gone to a different hospital. Dispatch placed me on a brief hold before advising they spoke to AMR dispatch and were told the ambulance just arrived at Riverside Community about 6 minutes ago.

I immediately sent Officer S. Klein and Officer J. Vasquez to Riverside Community Hospital for an update on Russell's condition. Officer Vasquez called me back within a couple of minutes of arriving at the hospital. He advised me that Russell was currently in cardiac arrest and the emergency staff was actively performing CPR on him. Within just a few minutes Officer Vasquez called back to advise me that Russell was pronounced dead by hospital emergency room staff. I advised my Watch Commander Sergeant M. Cobb of the incident and I responded to Riverside Community Hospital.

The AMR personnel who transported Russell were still on scene. Officer Klein and Officer Vasquez interviewed the paramedics and recorded their statement on BVS. Refer to their supplemental police reports for those interviews. I then made notifications to the Riverside County Coroner's Office and to Sergeant M. Crawford of the Riverside Police Department's Robbery/Homicide Unit. The Coroner's Deputies arrived and the investigation was turned over to Detective R. Cobb and Detective K. Corbett from Robbery/Homicide upon their arrival at Riverside Community Hospital.
