DETAILS:

13 On Thursday, March 8, 2018, I assisted Central Homicide Unit (CHU) Inv. Johnson with an Officer Involved
14 Shooting incident that occurred at 9931 Willowbrook Rd., Jurupa Valley, CA. My assignment was to manage
15 the charting of the Riverside Police Department officers involved with the shooting. This report reflects the
16 charting of RPD Officer Jeffrey Pap.
17

18 The charting of Officer Pap took place in the Community Room within the lobby of the Jurupa Valley Sheriff's
19 Station. Present for the charting was Riverside County Sheriff's Forensic Technician Jane Muschell, who
20 photographed process.
21

22 The charting process started at 11:04PM. Forensic Technician Muschell photographed Officer Pap's clothing
23 to memorialize the condition of his uniform at the time of the shooting. He wore (from head to toe) a black t-
24 shirt under a black load bearing (LBV) vest with various pouches sown onto it. The vest had a cloth RPD
25 badge sown on the left chest, a black name tape with J. PAP and a name tape that read POLICE sown onto the
26 right chest. The back of the LBV had a display patch that read POLICE adhered to it. He wore a black nylon
27 uniform belt with two dual magazine pouches, a dump pouch, a thigh holster with one leg strap. A fixed blade
28 knife and sheath and a tourniquet were mounted to the holster mount. He wore green BDU pants and black
29 boots.
30

31 At the time of the charting, Officer Pap's uniform belt was photographed on a sheet of butcher paper. The belt
32 contained (from right to left) two dual magazine pouches with four steel Wilson Combat 8-round handgun
33 magazines inserted in it. A black nylon dump pouch folded up. A handgun holster with one thigh strap for a
34 Springfield Armory 1911, .45 caliber, semi-automatic pistol (s/n: NM490093), with a mounted Streamlight
35 TLR-1 flashlight.

37 The firearm was loaded with one live round in the chamber, and loaded with eight live rounds in an 8-round
38 Wilson Combat steel handgun magazine. Each of the four magazines in the magazine pouch contained eight
39 live rounds. Forty-one rounds were accounted for on the duty belt. Each of the rounds had a head stamp that
40 read WINCHESTER 45 AUTO. Officer Pap explained he did not fire his handgun, and he loads his magazines
41 to capacity.
42

43 Next, Officer Pap's LVB was charted. It was removed and placed on a sheet of white butcher paper. The
44 contents of the vest were exposed and recorded. The vest housed a handheld radio and microphone, a can of
45 OC spray, a prybar, a flashlight, and a multi-tool.

47 The charting process revealed Officer Pap carried forty-one rounds on his duty belt. All of Officer Pap's
48 rounds are accounted for.

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3 The charting process ended at 11:57PM. Then, Officer Soria left the room. A short time later, he met with
4 Inv. Johnson and an interview was conducted.¹ The charting process continued with the charting of Officer
5 Henry Park.²

6 This is an open investigation and this report's status reflects such. A copy of this report was incorporated into
7 the investigation file managed by Investigator Johnson.
