### DETAILS:

On Thursday, March 8, 2018, I assisted Riverside County Sheriff Department Central Homicide Unit Investigator Anthony Johnson with an Officer Involved Shooting incident at 9931 Willowbrook Road, Jurupa Valley, CA 92509. As part of my responsibilities, I was assigned to interview [REDACTED] at the Jurupa Valley Sheriff Station.

[REDACTED] and I spoke in an interview Room within the Jurupa Valley Sheriff Station. At the onset of the interview, [REDACTED] provided her biographical information and identified the members of her family that were at the Willowbrook home at the time of the shooting. [REDACTED] described the actions of the involved parties and utilized a sketch as visual reference.<sup>1</sup>

[REDACTED] explained her cousin Ernie Saldivar was someone she recently met. She did not know his name and only met him a few months prior to March 2018. [REDACTED] went to the Willowbrook home to visit with her nephew [REDACTED]. Upon her arrival, she met with Ernie.

[REDACTED] arrived at the house several hours before the police arrived. She recalled getting a tour of the house and spending time with her young cousins. She added Ernie was at the house for the duration she was at the home. At some point, [REDACTED] walked into the garage and stood at the garage door talking to [REDACTED] and Ernie. [REDACTED] stood next to [REDACTED] while Ernie sat down on a chair in the garage, near the refrigerator. While they were talking, the police arrived and surprised [REDACTED]. She recalled the police officers walked up on them from the street. She did not know where they came from and was uncertain how many entered the garage. She was ordered to lay on the ground and she complied with those orders. [REDACTED] lay on her stomach with her head facing west, toward the car parked in the driveway. [REDACTED] saw two of the officers trained a gun on [REDACTED] and ordered him to lay on the ground. [REDACTED] complied with those orders and lay on the ground.

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3 [REDACTED] lay on the ground next to [REDACTED] with her head facing the vehicle parked in the driveway. [REDACTED] lay  
4 next to her with his head facing the garage. Each of them turned their heads to their right so they could look  
5 at each other.

6 As [REDACTED] was looking at [REDACTED] she heard the police shouting commands toward the back of the garage. She  
7 knew Ernie was sitting in a chair in the southeast corner of the garage and she saw the officers looking in that  
8 direction.

9 As the officers were moving in the garage, [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] what was happening, and he said he did not  
10 know. She then looked back into the garage and saw Ernie stand up and hurry across the garage and into the  
11 house on the north side of the garage. Ernie ran into the house and out of [REDACTED] sight. As he entered the house,  
12 [REDACTED] turned away and she heard about 5-6 gunshots. She immediately began crying, fearing Ernie was  
13 shot, hurt or killed.

14 Almost simultaneously, [REDACTED] called to the officers advising his wife and children were inside the home.  
15 [REDACTED] heard one officer call into the house advising that a woman and children were inside. A short time later,  
16 Stephanie and the kids came around the corner from the front of the house and saw [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] laying on  
17 the ground. She surmised they were escorted out the front door of the house and around the front yard.

18 [REDACTED] did not know why the police were at the house and did not hear Ernie say anything when the police arrived  
19 in the garage. As she spoke, she commented the police actions were sound and appropriate. She was not upset  
20 at the actions of the police and was understanding of their responses to Ernie's actions. She did not know what  
21 occurred inside the house to cause the police to fire their weapons, but she was compliant with their orders.  
22 [REDACTED] comments were supportive law enforcement and she did not make any disparaging or derogatory  
23 comments about law enforcement.

24 [REDACTED] did not recall any comments or statements Ernie made that caused her concern for her welfare or the  
25 welfare of the children. She also did not remember seeing Ernie possessing or displaying any weapons.

26 At the completion of the interview, [REDACTED] was returned to the Willowbrook residence to collect her dog and  
27 personal belongings. [REDACTED] was also provided my contact information and encouraged to contact me if she  
28 recalls anything pertinent to this investigation.

29 This is an open investigation and this report's status reflects such. A copy of this report was incorporated into  
30 the investigation file managed by Investigator Johnson.


