13 **AREA & SCENE DESCRIPTION:**

14 This scene is located within the incorporated area of Riverside County known as Jurupa Valley. This
15 area of Jurupa Valley is mainly residential, with several single-family residences. The primary crime scene
16 was identified as being within the two-car garage and laundry room area of 9931 Willowbrook St., Jurupa
17 Valley, a single story, 3,281 sqft. residence with five bedrooms and 2 3/4 bathrooms, on a .49-acre parcel of
18 land.

19 The Willowbrook St., roadway is a two-lane paved asphalt roadway for west/east traffic. The two
20 nearest roadways to the scene were identified as Foxborough Rd., to the west and Fairford St., to the east. The
21 traffic lanes of Willowbrook St., are not divided and there are curbs and sidewalks throughout the
22 neighborhood. It should be noted that upon arrival to the scene, 2030 hours, the lighting conditions were
23 moderate to good with clear skies. On the date of this investigation 03/08/18, the weather was noted as being
24 cool with slight winds.

25

26 The roadway areas of Willowbrook St. and Foxborough Rd., were maintained as a crime scene and
27 closed to all foot and vehicle traffic. All documentation, digital photography, scene investigation and
28 processing, was conducted and supervised by Investigator Manjarrez with the assistance of Forensic Tech's
29 Scott and Whaley. *(Refer to supplemental reports for further details)*

30

31 I have attached a copy of the 2018 Google Earth aerial/satellite photograph of the scene for
32 orientation purposes only. This photograph does not depict or is intended to depict the aerial/satellite view of
33 the location on the date of the incident and/or investigation. *(Refer to attached aerial/satellite photograph for*
34 *further details)*

35

36 **DETAILS:**

37 On Thursday, March 8, 2018, at approximately 1800 hours, Sergeant B. Ramirez of the Riverside
38 County Sheriff's Departments Central Homicide Unit (CHU) directed me to respond to 9931 Willowbrook
39 St., Jurupa Valley, in reference to an "Officer Involved Shooting" investigation. The suspect in this case was
40 later identified as **Ernie Saldivar**, of Riverside, California.

41

42 I arrived on scene at approximately 2030 hours and met with the remaining members of the Central
43 Homicide Unit, the Jurupa Valley Sheriff's Stations Investigations Bureau, the Riverside Police Department's

1 Internal Affairs. It should be noted and upon arrival, I noted that personnel from both the Riverside County
2 Sheriff's and the Riverside Police Department were out on Willowbrook St. and in front of the primary
3 residence, 9931 Willowbrook St., Jurupa Valley. At this point, I requested that all personnel move to the
4 intersection of Willowbrook St. and Foxborough Rd. and that the Command Post be located within this area,
5 so that all vehicle and foot traffic was minimized along Willowbrook St., from just west of the Foxborough
6 Rd. intersection, to the east intersection of Fairford St.

7
8 Once the perimeter was extended and all involved personnel were on scene, a briefing was held on
9 the known facts. I was tasked to assist Investigator Johnson, while Investigator's Barajas and Manjarrez were
10 tasked with the Officer Chartings and Scene Investigation and Processing. Investigator Johnson will cover
11 the details of the briefing in a supplemental report.

12
13 At the conclusion of the briefing, I joined Investigator's Johnson, Barajas, Manjarrez, and Peters, as
14 well as DDA Cook, DA Inv. Campos and Forensic Tech's Scott and Whaley, in a walkthrough of the crime
15 scene. Entry into the scene was made along the west intersection of Willowbrook St. and Foxborough Rd.,
16 east along the paved roadway toward the front door and entryway of 9931 Willowbrook St., Jurupa Valley.

17
18 The primary crime scene was identified as being within the two-car garage door and laundry
room/hallway, which is mainly on the westside of the residence. Once through the front door and entryway,
I noted that there two small rooms to the left and right of the doorway. The room to the left appeared to be a
21 formal dining room with a large table and chairs, while the room on the right was more of a sitting area with
22 some recliners. North of the entryway was the living room, which ran west toward the kitchen, while the
23 bedrooms were along the eastside of the residence.

24
25 The only rooms found to have direct connection and access to the primary crimes scene, were the
26 formal dining room, living room and kitchen. From the kitchen and living room area, which was just north of
27 the two-garage and laundry room/hallway, I could see the body of a Hispanic male adult, who was later
28 identified to be Ernie Saldivar. Saldivar was lying face-up, with his head toward the kitchen and his legs
29 toward the garage. I noted that Saldivar was wearing a black shirt that appeared to have cut and there were
30 medical pads attached to his chest and what looked like an intubation tube in his mouth. He also had on some
31 dark colored shorts, white socks and white tennis shoes with black laces. I could see that his hands were
32 handcuffed and under his torso and there was what appeared to be blood along his face, chest and right arm.
33 There also appeared to be blood along the tile floor, where he lay.

34
35 The only other item of interest that I noted, was that there was a black colored handgun and magazine
36 on the granite counter top and cabinet that was just to the left of where Saldivar was lying. No further
37 movements were made into the hallway/laundry room, as a search warrant was being authored for the
38 property/residence, 9931 Willowbrook St., Jurupa Valley. (*Refer to supplemental reports for further details*)

39
40 Once I had cleared the interior of the residence, I walked around and toward the open two-car garage
41 where the "*Officer Involved Shooting*" was reported to have occurred. As I looked through and into the
garage, I could see that there was a group of chairs along the southside of the garage and that the door to the
43 laundry room was along the north wall of the garage. This was where Saldivar was reported to have entered
44 the residence, when he was first contacted by the Officers and where the shooting occurred. No further
45 movement was made into the garage.
