Narrative

The following police vehicles were on scene and equipped with COBAN video recorders. Buffered video was recovered from them by Reuel Hinojales from IT:

Unit 3517 Officers Hunt and Feimer

The video from this unit shows the officers responding to the call and following Officer De La Torre, who is on his motorcycle.

7:00:32 - The officers arrive at the Stater Brothers.

7:00:53 - The officers stop and speak to a male in the parking lot who appears to be a Stater Brothers employee, then they split up and Officers Hunt and Feimer drive south through the parking lot.

07:02:00 - The officers are flagged down by W-Brown, the uniformed Security Guard, who leads them over into the parking lot at Washington Park. They stop the car and turn their spot lights on. This illuminates S-Smith, who is across the parking lot near a tree. S-Smith is alternating between kneeling and standing and hyperactively moving all over the place. The officers then drive towards the area where S-Smith is and as they get closer S-Smith lays down on the ground and starts rolling around.

7:02:57 - The officers park their unit and due to the angle S-Smith is now just off-screen. Within a few seconds Officer Feimer is seen walking in front of the police car. He meets up with Officer Hunt and they slowly walk towards the area where S-Smith was. They stop as they reach the grass area and Officer De La Torre joins them there. They are all facing the spot where S-Smith was last seen.

7:04:00 - Sgt. Collins walks into the picture and seconds later they all slowly approach S-Smith (S-Smith is still off-camera). All of the officers are now off-screen too.

07:04:32 - Officer De La Torre is seen walking into the picture and dropping what is later known to be S-Smith's knife in the grass where we later located it. Officer De La Torre then walks back off screen in the direction he had come from.

07:09:32 - A police car shows up and parks in front of Sgt. Collins' unit. Officer Tonetti gets out and is putting on gloves as he walks over to the area off camera where the officers and S-Smith are.

07:13:32 - Sgt. Milby is seen running over to Officer Tonetti's police car and it appears he is retrieving and putting on gloves. He then runs back over towards where the officers and S-Smith are.

07:13:53 - Officer De La Torre is seen running over to Officer Tonetti's police car. He gets in to the passenger door. He briefly gets out and signals to someone towards Mary Street with his flashlight and then retrieves something from inside the car which I believe is the CPR mask. Officer De La Torre then runs back over to where the officers and S-Smith are, just off-camera.

07:14:35 - Riverside Fire Department truck shows up and parks in the parking lot. Firefighters exit and head over to the area where the officers and S-Smith are.

07:17:56 - AMR ambulance arrives.

07:33:28 - S-Smith is loaded into the ambulance and transported.

The rest of the video shows the Fire Department leaving and officers in the area awaiting Investigators.

UNIT 3131 Sgt. Collins

07:03:07 - Sgt. Collins arrives at Washington Park. As Sgt. Collins parks his car Officer De La Torre is visible in front of him, stationary, sitting on his motorcycle in the parking lot. S-Smith is on the grass out in front of him. S-Smith is moving all over the place and then he lies on the ground on his stomach. Within a few seconds S-Smith pops up on his knees and starts rubbing his face. Sgt. Collins parks his car and S-Smith is still visible, but is at the extreme right edge of the screen. The rest of the incident takes place on the right edge of the screen.

07:03:30 - Sgt. Collins is seen walking in front of his car, towards the direction where Officer Feimer and Hunt are off-screen. S-Smith is seen moving all around, hyperactively moving from his knees to his stomach and rolling around on the ground. S-Smith doesn't appear to be able to remain still at all.

07:04:10 - Officers are seen approaching and making contact with S-Smith, who is now lying flat on his stomach on the ground. There is no apparent struggle although S-Smith's legs are constantly moving.

07:04:57 - S-Smith is handcuffed, rolled onto his side and searched. S-Smith cannot keep still and his legs are kicking, although he does not appear to be trying to kick the officers at all.

07:05:05 - Sgt. Collins says something into his radio. S-Smith is sitting up leaning against Officer Feimer's leg. The officers are standing around.

07:07:20 - Officer Feimer moves away from S-Smith and S-Smith is now lying all the way on the ground on his back. S-Smith is fidgeting all over and one of the officers leans over and appears to be trying to calm S-Smith down. The same officer then rolls S-Smith on his side and appears to be checking his handcuffs. S-Smith then rapidly spins and rolls away from the officer and a short struggle ensues. Within a few seconds S-Smith is lying still and the officers are just

holding him. All of the sudden S-Smith kicks out with his feet and pushes Officer Feimer back. Officer Feimer had been holding S-Smith's feet. Officer Feimer regains control. There is an officer on either side of S-Smith and Officer Feimer is holding his feet. There is no more struggling.

07:09:11 – The officers and S-Smith are stationary and Sgt. Collins is seen walking around them speaking on his radio several times.

07:09:43 – Sgt. Milby and Officer Tonetti appear on-scene and walk over to them.

07:10:30 – The officers appear to notice that S-Smith may be unconscious. The officer on his left, Officer De La Torre, stands up and Sgt. Collins leans over and checks on S-Smith. Sgt. Milby gets on his radio. Officer Hunt starts sternum rubs.

07:12:34 – It appears the handcuffs are taken off of S-Smith and chest compressions begin.

07:15:09 – Riverside Fire Personnel have arrived and are on-scene with the officers and S-Smith.

The rest of the video is RFD taking over medical care of S-Smith and AMR putting him on the gurney and taking him off screen.

Unit 3403 Sgt. Milby

This video begins at the Lincoln station and shows Sgt. Milby responding to Washington Park.

07:09:21 – Sgt. Milby arrives at Washington Park. As he pulls into the parking lot Sgt. Collins' and Officers Hunt and Feimer's marked police units are visible parked in the parking lot with spotlights shining on the area in front of them. Officer De La Torre's motorcycle is parked between them.

07:09:37 – Sgt. Milby pulls right up to the curb closest to the spot where the officers and S-Smith are and parks. The video captures the incident in the left side of his camera screen. S-Smith is already being held down on the ground with Officer De La Torre on his left, Officer Hunt on his right and Officer Feimer holding his legs.

07:09:47 – Officer Tonetti walks up to the officers and S-Smith while putting on gloves.

07:10:19 – Officer De La Torre stands up. S-Smith is not moving at all. The officers roll him over on his side and Officer Hunt starts sternum rubs. Sgt. Milby can now be seen near the officers and he gets on his radio.

The rest of the video shows the same thing I have already described in the other videos, but this recording shows the individual officer's actions more clearly from this point on due to the camera being closer to what is occurring.
