**Notification:**

On Saturday 02-18-12 at approximately 1500 hours, Sergeant C. Dinco contacted me at home and advised me that an officer involved shooting just occurred. At his request I responded to the scene at 5652 Harold Street to assist with the investigation. I arrived at approximately 1500 hours and I met with assisting detectives from the Robbery/Homicide Unit. We were briefed by witness Officer Dawson Smith who provided us with details surrounding the incident. After the briefing, I was assigned to handle the crime scene investigation with assistance from ID Technician Tim Ellis. Detective David Smith was assigned as the case agent in charge of the overall investigation.

**Crime Scene Description:**

The location of occurrence was in a residential neighborhood on Harold Street in the city and county of Riverside. It was daylight, the streets were dry and the weather was clear. Directionally Harold Street runs north/south. The primary crime scene where the incident occurred was on the west sidewalk of Harold Street directly to the front of a residence bearing the address 5652 Harold.

Upon my arrival, I noted yellow crime scene tape was used by Patrol Officers to block off all vehicle and pedestrian traffic on Harold Street approximately 100' north of and 100' south of the sidewalk in question. I further noted the body of a deceased male who was later identified as S/Bond was lying on the west sidewalk immediately to the front of the driveway at 5652 Harold. Evidence Technician Tim Ellis used a fabric barricade to block the view of the body from civilian onlookers. Uniformed Patrol Officers were also present guarding evidence items lying near the body as well as on the sidewalk and parkway to the front of 5652 Harold Street.

**Description of S/Bond:**

Bond was lying on his back on the sidewalk to the front of 5652 Harold Street. His head was facing south and his feet were facing north. Bond's hands were handcuffed behind his back by the involved officers. Bond was wearing dark sunglasses, a gray baseball cap, a red T-shirt, blue jeans, white and blue tennis shoes, and a heavy weight tan colored jacket. There was a substantial amount of blood present on Bond's face and clothing and there was a small pool of blood present next to him on the sidewalk. I noted there was a Colt .45 caliber handgun lying on the sidewalk immediately west of Bond's left hand. A magazine was inserted inside of the magazine well and the hammer was cocked back in position ready for the weapon to be fired. Additionally I noted one empty magazine and several expended shell casings near the body.

**Related Crime Scene Vehicles:**

Patrol Unit # 3616 was parked with the front end pointed at an angle facing north/west approximately 43' north of Bond's body. The unit was positioned across the driveway at 5664 Harold as if it was being used to block the sidewalk. I further noted that there was a red "MOTIV" Bicycle lying on the sidewalk just south of the patrol unit.

Witness Officer Dawson Smith was driving a [REDACTED] bearing license number [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] was part of the crime scene and it was parked approximately 37' south of where Bond's body was lying on the sidewalk. The front end was also pointed north/west blocking the sidewalk south of Bond's body.

**Processing of the Crime Scene & Evidence Collected:**

ID Technician T. Ellis began processing the crime scene by taking video and digital photographs of the entire scene. We identified and collected (12) .45 caliber expended shell casings on the sidewalk, driveway, lawn, and in the parkway near 5652 Harold Street. The .45 Caliber Colt handgun lying next to Bond was also marked, photographed, and collected as evidence. It was later confirmed to have been reported stolen out of LA County in 1998. We also collected the red MOTIVE brand bicycle that Bond was seen riding. Lastly we observed and collected a tactical Opps plan from the front passenger seat of patrol unit #3616 related to the wanted flyer, surveillance, and arrest plan for Danny James Bond.

**Processing Bond's Body on Scene:**

After collecting all identified evidence, Deputy Coroner D. Ball responded and examined Bond's body on scene. Deputy Ball examined Bond for injuries by lifting his shirt and exposing two possible GSW's to the front of his right and left shoulders. I observed a possible graze wound to Bond's front left side. Deputy Ball lifted the jacket Bond was wearing and a spent projectile and some bullet fragments fell out onto the sidewalk. The projectile and fragments were collected as evidence.

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Deputy Ball rolled Bond over onto his stomach. He then removed the handcuffs from Bond and Ellis collected them as evidence. I noted several apparent bullet holes or tears to the back of Bond's jacket. Deputy Ball removed the jacket and we collected it as evidence. Upon further examination Bond had approximately six apparent GSW's to his back and one additional GSW to his left buttock.

The coroner's office took custody of Bond and they transported him to the Riverside Coroner's Office. Other than his jacket the remaining clothing Bond was wearing remained on his body with the exception of his shoes which Ellis collected. We cleared the scene at approximately 2110 hours. Steri Clean, a crime scene cleaning service responded to clean and disinfect the sidewalk area of the blood.

**Search for additional Bullet Strikes:**

Tim Ellis photographed what might have been a possible bullet strike mark on the sidewalk where Bond's body was lying. We saw no other evidence of additional strike marks or damage to personal property due to the impact of any stray rounds. For complete details of all photographs, measurements, and a list of the evidence collected from the crime scene refer to the evidence report and sketch by Tim Ellis.
