1 **RELATED REPORTS:**

2 P13-026-492 – Stolen Vehicle report from Ross' parking lot.
3

4 **BACKGROUND:**

5 W1/Antonia's 1994 Burgandy Honda Accord (4EFE501) had been stolen earlier in the night from the
6 Ross parking lot at Arlington and Madison.
7

8 **NARRATIVE:**

9 On 02-25-13, at approximately 2049 hours, I was dispatched to 7911 Arlington reference the vehicle
10 burglary in progress. Dispatch advised that the reporting party, later identified as W3/Juan Rodriguez-
11 Rocha, was not providing specific information about the suspect's location or the vehicle being broken
12 into. Upon arrival, I parked my patrol unit outside of the apartment complex and began to walk in. I
13 noticed W3/Juan standing to the front of the apartment complex speaking with the Police Dispatcher on
14 his cellphone. I contacted W3/Juan.
15

16 I asked W3/Juan where the suspect was. W3/Juan pointed to the west side of the complex and began to
17 walk in that direction. As we walked into the apartment complex, he advised me that there was a male
18 subject, later identified as S1/Lorenzo Ciaramella, who had stolen his sister's vehicle and was attempting
19 to break into other vehicles. I noticed several subjects, including a female, later identified as W1/Antonia
20 Rodriguez-Rocha, a male (her husband) later identified as W2/Aroldo Cisnero-Pinto, and W1's father
21 (See Ofc. Loera supplemental for W1's father's statement), standing by a red colored SUV. The SUV was
22 parked directly behind a red colored Honda Accord, W-Antonia's stolen vehicle.
23

24 While speaking with W3/Juan Rodriguez Rocha and his family, a light colored, 4 door, Honda Civic,
25 approached the west gate and was waiting for the gate to open to exit. The vehicle was occupied by a
26 single male occupant, S1/Ciaramella. W3/Juan, W1/Antonia, and W2/ Cisnero-Pinto, all pointed at the
27 light colored Honda Civic and told me that the subject inside the vehicle was the suspect.
28

29 As the gate opened, S1/Ciaramella rammed the gate with the vehicle. When S1/Ciaramella noticed me,
30 he quickly started to back up. I walked through the partially opened gate and ordered the suspect to stop.
31 S1/Ciaramella ignored my commands, made a U-turn, and drove north through the complex. As
32 S1/Ciaramella was making a U-turn, I advised dispatch of the vehicle's license plate. Dispatch advised
33 the vehicle was registered to the apartment complex.
34

35 I knew the lay out of the complex and knew that the only two exits/entrances to the complex were through
36 south side. I believed S1/Ciaramella would drive north into the complex to create distance between us
37 then flee on foot. I chased the suspect vehicle as it went north through the complex and noticed the
38 suspect vehicle abruptly brake and quickly make a right turn, east, through the complex. I updated
39 Dispatch on the suspect description and location. I briefly lost the suspect vehicle. As I continued east
40 through the complex, I noticed the suspect vehicle driving in reverse back north through the complex and
41 a Patrol Unit was following it.

1 I made my way back towards the west gate of the complex because I believed the suspect vehicle was
2 going back that way. As I ran through the complex, I heard several shots fired (approximately 8-10). I ran
3 to the west gate of the complex and noticed the suspect vehicle had collided into the patrol unit. I noticed
4 S1/Ciaramella was laying back on the driver's seat and had been shot. I assisted in removing
5 S1/Ciaramella from the vehicle and laying him on the ground. AMR and RFD personnel arrived shortly
6 after and began treating the suspect. A crime scene was established and an investigation began.
7

8 During the investigation, I contacted and interviewed W3/Juan, W1/Antonia, and W2/Cisnero-Pinto,
9 respectively. I spoke with W3/Juan Rodriguez-Rocha who told me the following, in summary; he and
10 W2/Aroldo noticed W1/Antonia's vehicle pull into a parking stall on the outside of the west gate.
11

12 W1/Antonia's vehicle had been stolen earlier in the night, see RPD file # P13-026492. The vehicle was
13 occupied by a sole occupant, S1/Ciaramella. W3/Juan used his vehicle to block the suspect in and prevent
14 him from talking the vehicle again. After blocking the vehicle in, S1/Ciaramella and W3/Juan exited their
15 vehicles.
16

17 W3/Juan asked S1/Ciaramella, what was he doing in his car. S1/Ciaramella told W3/Juan that it was his
18 car and began to walk away towards the entrance of the complex. S1/Ciaramella turned around and ran
19 back to W1/Antonia's vehicle and got in it. S1/Ciaramella started the vehicle and backed into W3/Juan's
20 SUV which was still blocking the stolen vehicle in. When S1/Ciaramella attempted to flee in
21 W1/Antonia's vehicle failed, he exited the vehicle and walked into the complex. He attempted to force
22 open another vehicle (Honda Accord, License plate 6CBB821) but was unsuccessful. He moved over to
23 another vehicle (Honda Civic, License plate 6DHW305) and again attempted force his way into it, but
24 was unsuccessful. S1/Ciaramella ran north through the complex. W3/Juan walked to the front of the
25 complex and met with the officer.
26

27 W3/Juan said that once I was on scene and they pointed S1/Ciaramella out to me, he heard me tell
28 S1/Ciaramella to stop the vehicle. He then went and hid by the side of the building. He then saw
29 S1/Ciaramella driving the vehicle, in reverse, out of the west gate. S1/Ciaramella collided into his SUV
30 which was still blocking W1/Antonia's vehicle in. S1/Ciaramella stopped the vehicle. He heard officers
31 yelling at S1/Ciaramella, but could not understand what they were telling him because of the language
32 barrier. W3/Juan heard about 5 to 10 shots, but was not sure.
33

34 I spoke with W1/Antonia who told me the following, in summary; earlier in the night, her vehicle was
35 stolen, RPD file # P13-026492, from the Ross Department store in the area of Madison and Arlington.
36 She called her brother, W3/Juan, so that he could take them (W1, W2, and their baby) home. When
37 W3/Juan dropped them off at their apartment complex, she began walking towards her apartment. She
38 heard her husband, W2, say "there's the car". W3/Juan parked his SUV behind her vehicle (the stolen
39 vehicle). S1/Ciaramella and W3/Juan both exited their vehicles. W3/Juan told S1/Ciaramella, "that's our
40 car, why do you have my car". S1/Ciaramella replied "that's my car because I'm driving it" and walked
41 away, towards the front of the complex. W3/Juan, W2/Aroldo, and W1's father followed behind
42 S1/Ciaramella and told her to call the police. W1/Antonia said that she was unable to call the Police
43 because she was carrying her baby and froze. She told them to call the police and W3/Juan called the
44 police.

1 S1/Ciaramella turned around and walked back to her vehicle (stolen vehicle) and got in it again.
2 W2/Aroldo got into the SUV and applied the brakes to prevent S1/Ciaramella from pushing it with the
3 vehicle. S1/Ciaramella attempted to back out of the stall and collided into W3/Juan's SUV. W1/Antonia
4 heard the tires to her vehicle screeching as S1/Ciaramella attempted to back out of the stall. S1/Ciaramella
5 exited the vehicle and walked into the complex through the west gate.
6

7 S1/Ciaramella attempted to open two other vehicle's (Honda Accord, License plate 6CBB821 and a
8 Honda Civic, License plate 6DHW305), but was unsuccessful. S1/Ciaramella walked north through the
9 complex and W2/Aroldo followed him.
10

11 Shortly after, an officer arrived. As they were explaining to the officer what happened, S1/Ciaramella
12 drove up to the gate and they pointed out S1/Ciaramella to the Officer. W1/Antonia said she then hid to
13 the side. W1/Antonia appeared to be confused when relaying what happened after they pointed out
14 S1/Ciaramella to me.
15

16 W1/Antonia then said when S1/Ciaramella attempted to exit the west gate the second time, he was
17 successful. She then heard tires screeching and saw S1/Ciaramella attempting to ram the patrol unit
18 because he did not want to stop. She also heard officers yelling commands (approximately 3 times) for
19 S1/Ciaramella to stop or get out of the vehicle. S1/Ciaramella ignored the commands. She then heard a
20 collision and after the collision, heard approximately 6 shots. W1/Antonia said she does not know
21 S1/Ciaramella, she has never seen him, and he did not have permission to have her vehicle.
22

23 I spoke with W2/Aroldo who provided me with a similar statement as W1/Antonia and W3/Juan, but
24 added, in summary; that after S1/Ciaramella attempted to break into the two vehicles (Honda Accord,
25 License plate 6CBB821 and Honda Civic, License plate 6DHW305) inside the complex and continued
26 north through the complex, he followed him.
27

28 As he followed S1/Ciaramella, he watched as S1/Ciaramella attempted to force his way into several other
29 vehicles. S1/Ciaramella was finally successful and got into the Honda Civic that he was trying to flee in.
30 W2/Aroldo saw a neighbor in a black vehicle and told him that S1/Ciaramella was stealing cars. The
31 neighbor followed S1/Ciaramella his vehicle and W2/Aroldo went back to front of the complex. There,
32 W2/Aroldo noticed S1/Ciaramella attempting to leave in the stolen vehicle and pointed him out the
33 officer. He saw when S1/Ciaramella went north through the complex after seeing the officer.
34

35 He then noticed S1/Ciaramella driving, in reverse, out of the west gate. S1/Ciaramella's vehicle collided
36 with his parked SUV and kept driving in reverse. He saw when S1/Ciaramella put his vehicle in drive and
37 rammed the police unit. Officers then shot S1/Ciaramella. W2/Aroldo did not hear the officers give
38 S1/Ciaramella commands and does not know how many shots were fired. W2/Aroldo told me that he does
39 not know S1/Ciaramella and had never seen him before. S1/Ciaramella did not have permission to have
40 their vehicle.
41

42 All interviews were captured in detail on my Department issued digital recorder.
