Narrative of Supplemental Report:

On 02/25/13 at approximately 2049 hours I responded to the listed location from the Lincoln Street Police Station reference a radio dispatch of a possible GTA in Progress. Assisting Officers had arrived on scene, located a possible suspect and were in pursuit of him in the apartment complex. As officers attempted to apprehend the suspect, they became involved in an officer involved shooting. Upon arriving at the location I observed several officers attempting to extract the suspect from a vehicle. Medical aid had already been summoned and once the suspect was removed from the vehicle he was laid on the ground near the driver's door of the suspect vehicle. Medical aid arrived on scene and transported the suspect to Riverside Community Hospital.

Initially, I spoke to Officer Fast, who had informed me that he was one of the officers who had fired his weapon at the suspect. I obtained a safety brief from Officer Fast and then coordinated with Sergeant Tipre, who had obtained a safety brief from Officer Oakes, who had also discharged his weapon at the suspect. Sergeant Tipre advised he would handle transportation of the involved officers to the Magnolia Police Station. I then directed officers to establish a perimeter around the crime scene. I also directed additional officers to attempt to locate and obtain statements from potential witnesses and coordinated the transportation of the witnesses to the Magnolia Police Station for additional interviews.

I then assisted Officer Hibbard in locating shell casing in the area of the crime scene. All shell casings located by me and Officer Hibbard were marked with notebook paper to clearly mark their location. I then responded to all police vehicles in the crime scene equipped with COBAN and turned off the recorders. Once the crime scene was secure and a crime scene log had been started I stood by near the entrance of the apartment complex and waited for the

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arrival of homicide personnel. During this time I obtained a brief synopsis of the incident from Officer Disla, who had interviewed several witnesses.

Upon arrival of Homicide personnel I briefed them on the circumstances involved in the incident. I then escorted them into the crime scene to visually inspect the evidence. After assisting Homicide personnel I cleared the scene at approximately 0015 hours. Sergeant Russell and Sergeant Amador assumed scene responsibility at that time.
