Narrative of Supplemental Report:

At approximately 0335 hours I responded to Anna St. / Lincoln Ave. reference an 11-99 request at the scene of an Officer Involved Shooting. On arrival I parked behind Unit 3134 which was parked in the northbound lane behind a white minivan. At that time I noticed Officer Brt. Porter was just south of my patrol car looking over the rear wall to the backyard of 2914 Hyde Park Circle. I climbed the wall and found Officer Lopez detaining a suspect at gunpoint. Officer Lopez was ordering the suspect to lay still and advising him medical aid was on the way. The suspect was handcuffed, laying on his back, in the grass with his head facing in a north easterly direction. The suspect was rocking from his back to his side, bleeding through his clothing, complaining of pain and difficulty breathing. There was a silver handgun, with the hand grips wrapped in electrical tape, on the ground just above and to the left of the suspect's head. Officer Hibbard had also entered the yard, covering an expended round below the suspect's feet.

I obtained a public safety briefing from Officer Lopez reference the direction, trajectory and number of rounds fired. Officer Lopez stood at the west wall of the backyard, pointed north easterly with his arms in a "V" shaped pattern and advised he fired approximately six rounds in that direction. I directed Officer Glover to photograph the weapon and expended shell casing in case those items needed to be moved while medical personnel rendered medical aid to the suspect. I directed responding officers in establishing an inner perimeter as Sgt. Ruddy assisted in establishing the outer perimeter. AMR and RFD personnel responded to the scene, transporting the suspect to Riverside Community Hospital.

I remained on scene assisting Lt. Brennan with inner and outer perimeter duties and providing a debrief for the OIS Team. Once completed I was relieved from the scene by Sgt. Russell.
