62. Narrative of Supplemental Report
-Transported Suspect's Weapon-

On 03-01-12, at approximately 0315 hours, I was contacted by Sergeant D. Amador and asked to respond to the area of Anna Street and Lincoln Avenue, in the city and county of Riverside, regarding an Officer Involved Shooting investigation. I arrived on scene at approximately 0430 hours. I attended a briefing of the incident and was then asked to assist Detective Rick Cobb and Supervising Forensic Technician C. Fuller with processing the crime scene. Refer to their Supplemental Reports for crime scene details.

While assisting at the scene, I was asked to transport the suspect's handgun (Taurus .9mm semi-auto; Model PT92AF, Serial# [REDACTED]) to the Riverside Police Department Firing Range, located at 8181 Lincoln Avenue, Riverside, to get assistance in clearing a malfunction and rendering the gun safe. I took custody of the weapon, at approximately 1010 hours, and brought it Range Master/Firearm Instructor E. Dorothy (#1472). At approximately 1020 hours, E. Dorothy was able to clear the weapon, which had one round in the chamber, and render it safe. I retook possession of the weapon at that time and transported it to the Riverside Police Department, Magnolia Station, and stored it in the vault within the Forensic Unit.
