Narrative:

On 06-11-2013, 2330 hours, I received a call from Sergeant Dave Amador. Sergeant Amador told me an Officer Involved Shooting occurred at Van Buren Blvd. and the 91 Freeway. Sergeant Amador requested that I respond to the scene to assist with the investigation.

I arrived on-scene on 06-12-2013 at about 0005 hours. Detective Rick Wheeler was assigned as the case agent of the investigation. Detective Wheeler informed me that the suspect vehicle was involved in a collision on the 91 freeway just prior to the Officer Involved Shooting (O.I.S.) Detective Wheeler directed me to contact Rae Perry who was the driver of a vehicle involved in the collision.

I contacted Rae Perry who was sitting in her husband's vehicle which was parked in the Alberto's restaurant parking lot. I interviewed Rae Perry while sitting inside my Riverside Police Department assigned police vehicle. The interview was audio recorded using my department issued PUMA recorder. The following is a summary of the interview with Rae Perry.

Rae said she was driving her Chrysler 300 westbound on the 91 freeway. Her daughter, [REDACTED] was sitting in the front passenger seat. Her son, [REDACTED] was sitting in the rear left passenger seat. Rae believed she was in the #1 or #2 lane due to just entering on the freeway from the Adams Street on-ramp.

[REDACTED] said her vehicle was suddenly struck by another vehicle in the rear left quarter panel. Rae said this caused her to lose control of her vehicle which began spinning in a circle. Rae said her vehicle ended up stopping against the north embankment of the 91 freeway facing east bound in the west bound lane. Rae did not see the vehicle that struck her.

Rae said she and her children exited her vehicle and walked up onto the freeway embankment. She noticed a large 18 wheel semi-truck driver had pulled over and asked if she was alright. Rae described the driver as being a medium build, Black male. The truck driver told Rae that he saw the vehicle that struck her. He described the vehicle as a small burgundy compact car. Rae said the Black male truck driver left the scene after determining that they were not injured. She did not believe the truck driver was involved in the collision and did not know if he had called police to report the collision.

I asked Rae if she heard any gunshots after the collision. Rae said she saw and heard several police vehicles in the area but did not hear any gunshots. Rae did not see any pedestrians on the freeway or near the Van Buren off-ramp. Rae could not provide a description of the vehicle or the occupants of the vehicle involved in the collision with her. Rae said she did not know that a shooting had occurred until California Highway Patrol Officers (C.H.P.) contacted her to take a collision report. Rae could not remember the name of the C.H.P. officer that assisted her and took the traffic collision report.

Rae said she called a private tow company to remove her vehicle from the freeway. At the conclusion of the interview, Rae and her husband met with the tow truck driver on the freeway to remove their vehicle.
