SUMMARY/RESULTS

Both pistols functioned properly during examination and test firing.

Per request of the submitting agency, a test fired cartridge case from the Beretta pistol was entered into the National Integrated Ballistic Information Network (NIBIN) and searched against the current database. No retrieved images that warranted additional work were found.

EXAMINATION

Item WL002 was identified as a Glock Model 22 semiautomatic pistol chambered to fire .40 S&W caliber ammunition. The capacity of the submitted magazine is fifteen .40 S&W caliber rounds. The pistol's disconnecter and safeties were found to be working. The pistol was test fired using the submitted magazine and three of the submitted rounds. The pistol functioned properly during examination and test firing.

Item SF-03 was identified as a Beretta Model 3032 Tomcat semiautomatic pistol chambered to fire .32 Auto caliber ammunition. The capacity of the submitted magazine is seven .32 Auto caliber rounds. The pistol's disconnect and safety were found to be working. The pistol was test-fired using the submitted magazine and three rounds from of Laboratory. The pistol functioned properly during examination and test firing.

Per request of the submitting agency, a test fired cartridge case from the Beretta pistol was entered into the National Integrated Ballistic Information Network (NIBIN) and searched against the current database. No retrieved images that warranted additional work were found.

DISPOSITION

The evidence will be held pending release to the submitting agency. The test fired bullets and cartridge cases will be stored at the laboratory.
