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DETAILS:

On 09-13-13, at about 2200 hours, Ofc. Espinoza and I were dispatched to the command post of an officer involved shooting at 10th and Sedgwick. Upon arrival I spoke to Sgt. Wilson who directed me to go to [REDACTED] to contact a possible witness by the name of Cindy Covington. Sgt. Wilson told me O/Covington may have been a witness to the shooting and possibly have video of the incident.

Upon arrival at [REDACTED] we contacted a lady on the front porch of the residence who refused to identify herself, other than to say she was the person who had called. We tried to interview this person, who I believe to be O/Covington, but she refused to say much to us and wanted to only talk to a "Sergeant or a Captain". I explained to her that all the supervisors were busy at the moment, but that I would be happy to document her statement. O/Covington spoke vaguely about sitting on her porch and seeing several police cars driving by without their headlights on. She said this was unsafe and Riverside Police could have killed more people than the one they already had. I asked her several times if she had any pertinent information in regards to the shooting itself, but she refused to answer telling me I was a "pee-on" and that if I did not get a Captain to her house she would just call the Chief herself. O/Covington was very uncooperative with me and eventually walked into her house after telling me she would just call the Chief rather than talk to me. I relayed this information back to Sgt. Wilson.

We were later directed by Sgt. Touissant to return to the Lincoln St. station and pick up a K9 pool car (Unit #3601) and bring it back to the scene, so that K9 Ofc. Feimer could remove his K9 partner (PSD Flash) from the interior of the crime scene. Ofc. Espinoza brought the pool car back to the crime scene. We were then relieved from further duties at the scene by Sgt. Touissant.
