

Narrative:

On 9-13-13 at approximately 2200 hours I responded to 2395 10th St in the City of Riverside for an officer involved shooting. Upon arrival Detective Sanfilippo was assigned as case agent and Detective Mike Medici as the co-case agent. I was assigned to process the scene with Detective Jim Simons and ID Techs Carlton Fuller, Susan Lane and Selena McKay-Davis. Sgt. Jeff Spencer was the scene supervisor. Deputy DA Michelle Paradise and DA Investigator Paul Edwards responded to the scene.

Sgt. Gary Toussaint briefed us on the incident. Sgt. Toussaint advised they were called to 2395 10th St for a suicidal subject with a knife. When they arrived the suspect was seated on a wood bench on the south side of the residence. Sgt. Toussaint said he attempted to get the suspect, identified as S/ Hector Jimenez, to put down the knife, but he refused. Sgt. Toussaint said the suspect came at the officers and a shooting occurred. Sgt. Toussaint advised three officers shot their handguns and one officer shot a less-lethal shotgun. Medical aid responded and pronounced the suspect deceased. Sgt. Toussaint then conducted a walk thru of the scene with the listed personnel with the exception of the coroner transport.

ID Tech Lane took video of the scene and McKay-Davis took overall photos of the outside of the residence at 2395 10th St. ID Tech Fuller did a sketch of the scene. I was advised that the Honorable Judge Richard Fields with the Riverside Superior Court signed a search warrant at 0216 hours for the residence at 2395 10th St in the City of Riverside and that it was endorsed for night service. I served the search warrant at 0225 hours and left a copy of the warrant inside the residence. I assisted in locating several items of evidence at the location. ID Techs Fuller, Lane, and McKay-Davis identified each evidence item with black and yellow numbered placards, photographed, measured and collected the items at the scene. I contacted O/ Carolina Perez, whose family owns the residence at 2395 10th St. O/ Perez said her family lives in the north portion of the residence and they rent the small room at the south end to S/ Hector Jimenez, his wife and a small child. O/ Perez said they were kicking the family out this Thursday. She said she didn't hear any

arguing earlier, but saw the police officers. She said she went into her house and heard gunshots. O/ Perez could not add anything else.

Scene:

The residence at 2395 10th St is located at the north east corner of 10th St and Sedgewick Ave in the City of Riverside, CA. The residence is surrounded by single family homes on the north, south and east. There is a church southwest of the residence. The residence is a single story home with the Perez family living in the north side. There is a driveway leading to a garage in the middle of the residence and the Jimenez family lives in a room at the south end. The south end room is a small room with a bathroom in the northwest corner. There are two beds on the east wall. There is a wood table below the window on the south wall. The front door is on the west side of the room and there is a door on the north wall that leads to the garage. There is a small kitchen area inside the front door with a refrigerator and a shelf containing food on the south wall.

The window on the south wall was broken. A lead projectile and copper jacket (Evidence item SL03) were located inside the double paned glass. There was a plastic basket located below the window that had two holes on the side closest to the south wall and one hole on the east side of the basket. The two holes in the basket closest to the south wall aligned with two exit holes from the dry wall on the inside of the south wall. The hole in the basket on the east side aligned with one of the holes on the south side and had a portion of a blanket sticking out of it. Inside the basket was a blanket that contained two lead projectiles (Evidence items SL01 & SL02). The projectiles were photographed and collected by ID Tech Lane. ID Tech Lane also photographed the inside of the room and did a sketch of the south portion of the room. See ID Tech Lane's supplemental report for details.

There is a 4' chain link fence that encloses the property on the south and west sides. There is a driveway in the middle of the residence off of Sedgewick Ave that extends from the street to the garage. There is a garden area south of the driveway and just west of the front door to the south room (Jimenez room). There is a grass area between the south side of the residence and the chain link fence. There are several trees planted throughout that area. There was a white plastic chair, barbeque and a wood bench on the sidewalk between the south wall of the residence and the grass area.

I conducted a search of the area with the ID Techs. There was a black handle knife with a silver blade (Evidence item RM01) located on the sidewalk at the southwest corner of the residence. There were (15) fifteen Winchester 40 S&W casings (Evidence items RM02 thru RM15) located in the grass area south of the residence. There were (4) four less lethal gray expended shotgun shells (Evidence items RM16 thru RM19) also located in the grass. There was a yellow less lethal bean bag round (Evidence item RM20) located on the grass just south of the sidewalk near S/ Jimenez and one on the sidewalk below the window (Evidence item RM21). There were several prescription bottles and medical wrist bands (Evidence item RM25) located on the grass near S/ Jimenez feet with his name on them. The prescriptions included [REDACTED]. See ID Tech Fuller's sketch for exact locations of the listed evidence items.

There were two lead projectiles (Evidence items RM30 & RM32) and wadding from the less lethal shotgun (Evidence items RM22 thru RM24 & RM25-A) found south of the residence. There were (6) six strike marks (Labeled A thru F) to the outside of the south wall. (2) Two of those strike marks went through the wall and into the plastic basket in the south room as described above. There was another strike mark (Labeled G) that went through the window on the south wall. ID Techs Fuller and McKay-Davis used probes to obtain the trajectory of several of the strike marks that penetrated the outside wall. See photographs.

S/ Jimenez was located in the grass area south of the sidewalk. He was laying on his right side facing south with both hands cuffed behind his back. S/ Jimenez had a black t-shirt, blue jeans and black boots on. There was blood on his pants, head, shirt and the grass surrounding him. Upon arrival at the scene there were media personnel with cameras and numerous citizens outside the yellow crime scene tape that could see the scene. ID Tech Fuller put a privacy screen just south of S/ Jimenez in the grass area.

Sedgewick Ave is a north/ south roadway and 10th St runs east/ west. The intersection of Sedgewick Ave and 10th St is controlled by a stop sign westbound 10th St at Sedgewick Ave. The area surrounding the scene was taped off with yellow crime scene tape. The scene was blocked for north and south bound traffic on Sedgewick Ave at 9th St and 11th St. There was also yellow crime scene tape blocking traffic from traveling west bound on 10th St.

There were (4) four police units parked at the corner of 10th St and Sedgewick Ave; Unit #3631 was on the northeast corner facing in a northwest direction; Unit #3130 was on the north curb of 10th St east of Sedgewick Ave facing east; Unit #3145 was on south curb of 10th St east of Sedgewick Ave facing east; and Unit #3917 was on the north curb of 10th St east of Sedgewick Ave (east of Unit #3130) facing east. I viewed the COBAN videos in each of those units. None of the units captured the incident on video. Jonathan David from the IT Department responded to the scene and removed the COBAN hard drives from each unit. They were taken to the station where they were downloaded to the server. There was a silver Ford Explorer, CA license 5YDE282, parked on the eastside of Sedgewick Ave facing north in front of 2395 10th St. There was also an AMR ambulance (Unit #31486) inside the scene in the middle of Sedgewick Ave facing north just west of Ford Explorer. After the ambulance was photographed in the scene it was released.

The area surrounding 2395 10th St was well lit on Sedgewick Ave and 10th St. The grass area south of the house between the south wall and the chain link fence was not very well lit (Darker than the intersection). There were street lights along the west side of Sedgewick Ave from University Ave to 14th St and along the south side of 10th St east from Sedgewick Ave. There was a street light on the southeast corner of 10th St and Sedgewick that provided some light to the area south of the residence.

Coroner investigation

Deputy Coroner Denise Ferris responded to the scene at approximately 2300 hours. She was part of the initial brief and walk thru of the scene. Deputy Coroner Ferris then left the scene while a search warrant was obtained and the evidence was collected. Deputy Coroner Ferris returned at approximately 0445 hours to conduct her investigation. She photographed S/ Jimenez and checked for injuries. Deputy Coroner Ferris located several possible gunshot wounds to S/ Jimenez head and torso. Deputy Coroner Ferris had the hand cuffs removed from S/ Jimenez wrists and she placed bags on both hands to preserve them for possible gunshot residue tests. The coroner transport, Ron and Quincy Moore, arrived and transported S/ Jimenez to the coroner's office at 0540 hours.
