26 and started to drink beers. S/Jimenez drinks about approximately 15 beers a day. S/Jimenez and V1 got  
27 into an argument over money. V1 told S/Jimenez that she was going to leave him and went to her dresser  
28 to pack her belonging. S/Jimenez came behind V1, grabbed, and pulled her hair. S/Jimenez held onto  
29 V1's hair as he turned her around and punched her twice on the right side of her face with his left closed  
30 fist. V1 grabbed onto a clothing hanger and started to hit S/Jimenez to defend herself. S/Jimenez then  
31 threw V1 on the bed. V1 got her cellular phone and attempted to call the police. S/Jimenez told her, "Oh,  
32 you are calling your police again," and knocked her cell phone out of her hand. V1 ran out of house and

1 V1 stated that she had high blood pressure and felt dizzy. We requested Riverside Fire Department (RFD)




