62. Narrative of Supplemental Report On 01-07-12 at about 1624 hrs., trainee Officer Moyano and I responded to assist patrol regarding shots fired. We responded from Arlington Ave. and Magnolia Ave. and arrived on scene at about 1629 hrs. Upon arrival, I stood by at the scene of the shooting near a grey vehicle, watching out for a pipe on top of a cart. I was told that the pipe was evidence. After the medical assistance personnel cleared the area, I also cleared. I contacted two subjects to the front of 10735 Cypress Ave., Phillip and Francisco Hurtado. Phillip stated that he was working on a vehicle in the driveway of 10735 Cypress. Francisco told him that a police car had just pulled up to the residence next door. Within a minute after he police car arrived, he heard several shots fired and people started yelling. Phillip did not see the shooting. Francisco told me that he was also working on the vehicle in the driveway of 10735 Cypress Ave. Francisco saw the police vehicle arrive at the house next door. about 30 seconds later, he heard an unknown amount of gunshots then people began yelling.
