Narrative of Supplemental Report:

On 1/9/2012, I received a verbal request from Senior Forensic Technician T. Ellis to complete aerial photographs of the incident scene, and to transport the following evidence items to the Riverside Department of Justice (DOJ) laboratory for analysis:

- Item #TE-1: "GLOCK 40 CALIBER SEMI AUTO PISTOL MODEL 22 SERIAL # [REDACTED]"
- Item #TE-1B: "(1) GLOCK MAGAZINE CONTAINING (9) WINCHESTER S&W 40 LIVE ROUNDS"
- Item #TE-2: "GLOCK 40 CALIBER SEMI AUTO PISTOL MODEL 22 SERIAL # [REDACTED]"
- Item #TE-2B: "(1) GLOCK MAGAZINE CONTAINING (6) WINCHESTER S&W 40 LIVE ROUNDS"
- Item #TE-3: "GLOCK 40 CALIBER SEMI AUTO PISTOL MODEL 22 SERIAL # [REDACTED]"
- Item #TE-3B: "(1) GLOCK MAGAZINE CONTAINING (11) WINCHESTER S&W 40 LIVE ROUNDS."

On 1/10/12, at 0933 hours, I checked out Items #TE-1, TE-1B, TE-2, TE-2B, TE-3, and TE-3B from Magnolia Station Police Property Specialist P. Trapp, and secured the items in my locked evidence cabinet. Later that day, I removed Items #TE-1, TE-1B, TE-2, TE-2B, TE-3, and TE-3B from my locked evidence cabinet, and transported the items to the Riverside DOJ for analysis. At 1150 hours, I released Items #TE-1, TE-1B, TE-2, TE-2B, TE-3, and TE-3B to Property Controller K. Kreuz. Refer to the attached Physical Evidence Submission Form, and BFS case #RI-12-000271. I cleared the Riverside DOJ and traveled to the RPD Aviation Unit. At 1228 hours, I arrived at the Aviation Unit, and contacted Aviation Officer D. Miskulin. I took (30) dig aerials photographs of the scene. I cleared the Aviation Unit at 1302 hours. I downloaded the photographs to a secure file format. No further action was taken.

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
