Narrative

On 11-18-14 at 1431 hrs I monitored Riverside Police radio traffic of an officer involved shooting (OIS) at 10479 Keller in the City of Riverside. I responded to that location and arrived at approximately 1310 hrs. I was appointed as the case agent and Detective Greg Rowe my co-case agent.

I attended a briefing at the scene and learned that Riverside Police Department (RPD) Narcotics Detective Eric Detmer had received information that a subject later identified as S-Martinez may be in possession of methamphetamine and a gun. The Narcotics detectives enlisted the assistance of the Post-release Accountability and Compliance Team (P.A.C.T) and they set up surveillance in the area of S-Martinez's residence, which was 5433 Bushnell in Riverside. The Bushnell address is directly behind 10479 Keller, which is where the shooting occurred.

At approximately 1431 hrs Officer Marco Ortiz and Officer Jeffrey Adcox, who are part of the P.A.C.Team, saw S-Martinez driving his gray 2014 Nissan Frontier a few blocks from the Bushnell address. They followed him in their unmarked police car, which was a black Ford Explorer equipped with spotlights, a forward facing red light, and a siren. At the intersection of Keller and Jones the officers saw S-Martinez fail to stop at the stop sign there and they activated their red light to pull him over. S-Martinez continued to drive, failing to stop for them. The officers then activated their siren and S-Martinez still failed to yield. Officer Christina Arangure and Officer Daniel Mercadefe, also on the P.A.C.Team, pulled in behind Officers Ortiz and Adcox in their similarly equipped black Ford Explorer and they both followed S-Martinez with lights and sirens as he continued to drive at approximately the speed limit. S-Martinez drove to his house at 5433 Bushnell, turned in to the driveway and accelerated to the end of the long driveway. The officers followed S-Martinez down the driveway where S-Martinez stopped his vehicle.

S-Martinez opened his driver's door, stepped out and stood outside of the driver's door facing the officers. Officers Ortiz and Adcox, who were in full police uniform, exited their police car, drew their firearms and ordered S-Martinez to get on the ground. Instead of getting on the ground S-Martinez put his hands up in the air and walked backwards away from them, past the front of his truck. He then turned and ran southbound through his backyard. Officers Ortiz and Adcox ran after him.

S-Martinez ran through his yard to the fence between his yard and the neighbors at 10479 Keller. S-Martinez climbed over the fence into the back yard of the Keller address and Officer Ortiz and Officer Adcox followed behind him. S-Martinez continued running for approximately 50 feet in a southerly direction in the backyard of the Keller address when he produced a handgun and was shot by police. Officer Arangure and Officer Mercadefe were just scaling the fence into the Keller address backyard when the shooting occurred. The officers requested medical aid and attempted first aid but S-Martinez was pronounced deceased by Riverside Fire personnel shortly after. Responding patrol officers to the incident secured the scene.

The gun S-Martinez possessed was located on the ground in the area of his body. Initial observations showed it was a Springfield .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun, loaded with (11) live .40 caliber rounds. The serial number was run and the gun was reported stolen in 2011 through the Riverside County Sheriff's Department.

Officers and Detectives conducted a canvas for witnesses and at this point no civilian witnesses to the shooting were located and there were no officer or civilian injuries.

Riverside Police Robbery Homicide Investigators processed the crime scene at 10479 Keller and 5433 Bushnell. The Riverside County Sheriff Coroner responded and took possession of S-Martinez and the belongings still on his person.

On 11-19-14 a plastic baggie of suspected methamphetamine was located in S-Martinez's pants pocket by Coroner's personnel. RPD Evidence techs collected it as evidence. On 11-20-14 I weighed and tested the substance at the Magnolia Police Station. The substance weighed approximately 15.0 grams with packaging. I tested it with a presumptive test kit and received a positive reaction for methamphetamine. I requested the baggie be processed for fingerprints.

Disposition

The investigation is continuing.
