EVIDENCE:

Item "EJD001" is a Black, Uniden Handheld scanner (found on the couch in the living room) and a magazine speed loader (found on the living room center table).

Item "EJD002" is a black, "Second Chance" ballistic vest (found in the S/E Bedroom on the bed).

Item "EJD003" is (2) metal knuckles, 1 nylon holster on nylon belt (found on the bed in the S/E bedroom).

Item "EJD004" is a Ruger, Model 10-22, .22 caliber rifle, serial number 24888208 (found in safe of master bedroom).

Item "EJD005" is a Mossberg, 12 gauge shotgun, unknown serial number (found in safe of master bedroom with "EJD004").

Item "EJD006" is (2) .22 caliber magazines (found with .22 caliber rifle).

Item "EJD007" is (20) .22 caliber rounds (found inside "EJD006").

Item "EJD008" is (37) rounds of 12 gauge shotgun shells (found in safe of master bedroom).

Item "EJD009" is (2) gun cases and (1) gun cleaning kit (found in south cabinet of rear laundry room).

Item "EJD010" is a green leafy substance believed to be marijuana (found on front porch in screw container).

SOURCE:

I am currently a detective assigned to narcotics. Recently I was contacted by a confidential source who stated that a subject by the name of Vicente Martinez was suspected of selling illegal narcotics. The confidential source has recently seen S/MARTINEZ driving a dark grey Nissan Frontier with a California License Plate of 70580R1. The confidential source also stated that he/she has recently seen S/MARTINEZ carrying a gun in his front right pocket and informed me that S/MARTINEZ has been using a lot of "speed" lately.

DETAILS:

I ran a records check on the license plate of 70580R1. I learned that this vehicle was registered to S/MARTINEZ at 5433 Bushnell Ave. in the City and County of Riverside. After making the necessary notifications and records checks, I met with Det. Chris Williams who is assigned to the Riverside PACT Team along with the listed officers.

Det. Williams and I discussed S/MARTINEZ past criminal contacts which included [REDACTED] I also notified Det. Williams and his team that it was believed S/MARTINEZ was in possession of a handgun. Det. Williams and I formulated a plan for the operation prior to leaving the police station.

At approximately 1400 hours, the listed detectives set up a surveillance of 5433 Bushnell Ave. Upon arrival I saw that the Nissan Frontier was not parked at the residence of the DMV Registration.

At approximately 1420 hours, Det. Lomeli spotted the suspect vehicle driving north on Jones Ave. Ofc. Adcox confirmed the plate. I asked Officer Adcox to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle.

The vehicle failed to yield for Ofc. Adcox and Ofc. Ortiz. I was parked on Bushnell Ave. north of Campbell Ave. I could see the Nissan Frontier driving west on Campbell Ave. towards Bushnell Ave. The Nissan Frontier was occupied only by the driver, S/MARTINEZ. The pursuing police units had their emergency lights and sirens activated as they turned south on Bushnell Ave.

As I was driving south on Bushnell Avenue, I heard the officer's broadcast that they were in foot pursuit of the suspect. As I was turning left (E/B) on Keller Ave. from Bushnell Avenue, I heard the officer's broadcast that they had "shots fired" and that no officers were injured. I responded to the termination point of the traffic stop.

Upon arrival, I saw that both Police Ford Explorer's still had their emergency lights activated. The Nissan Frontier's driver side door was open and the engine was still running. There was loud music playing from the vehicle's stereo which was limiting my ability to listen to the radio traffic. For this reason I turned off the ignition to the suspect vehicle.

I searched the back shed and rear yard of 5433 Bushnell Ave. (for additional suspects). I knocked on the front door of 5433 Bushnell and 5431 Bushnell (two separate residences on the same property). No one was home at either location.

I assisted in securing the scene for evidence. While doing so I spoke with Ofc. Adcox. He told me that he saw S/Martinez fail to stop at a stop sign on Jones Ave. in violation of 22450a VC.

At approximately 1705 hours, Det. Levesque obtained written/verbal consent to search from the homeowner that lives at 5431 Bushnell Ave. (see his supplemental report for further information). This homeowner also provided Det. Levesque with a key to both her residence and the residence at 5433 Bushnell.

Det. David Smith (case agent) obtained consent to search the residence at 5433 Bushnell Ave. (from the wife of S/MARTINEZ). The wife of S/MARTINEZ would not give consent for us to search her room.

Using the key we were given from the tenant of 5431 Bushnell, we (Sgt. David Ruddy, Det. Trinidad Lomeli, Det. Senon Saldana, and Det. Scott Levesque) conducted a search of the residence (at 5431 Bushnell). No significant items of evidence were located in this residence.

We conducted a search of 5433 Bushnell (S/MARTINEZ'S residence). Upon entry into the house we cleared it to be certain there was no one hiding inside the residence. We found two safe's inside the master bedroom while doing so. One of these safes was a small safe on the floor (S/E corner of the room) in plain view. The other safe was a floor safe in the closet.

In the living room to the right of the television, there was an operational monitor displaying a security camera that was operational and displaying a live video feed of the driveway (faces west from the front of the house). We traced the wires and couldn't locate any recording device attached to the camera.

On the table in the middle of the living room there was a black ammunition speed loader commonly used to load the magazines in semi-automatic firearms. On the couch of the living room there was a handheld scanner (Items EJD001).

On the bed of the southeast bedroom there was a ballistic vest (EJD002), (2) metal knuckles and 1 nylon black holster/belt (EJD003).

In the south cabinet of the back porch laundry room, Det. Saldana located (2) gun cases and (1) gun cleaning kit (EJD009).

In a small container on the front porch, I located a small quantity of marijuana (EJD010).

S/MARTINEZ'S wife returned to the residence and agreed to allow us to search inside the safe's inside her bedroom.

Inside the safe of the master bedroom we located a shotgun (EJD005), .22 caliber rifle (EJD004) and ammunition to these weapons (EJD006, EJD007, EJD008).

S/MARTINEZ'S wife asked that we take these items since they didn't belong to her and she wanted them out of the house.

S/MARTINEZ'S wife opened the floor safe. The safe contained a Glock Model 22 (ACR629US) and a Sig Sauer 9mm (24B069263). Both of these items were registered to her and she wanted to keep them in the house.

Det. Lomeli took photographs of the residence/evidence before, during and after the search.

At the conclusion of the search we left the scene. All items of evidence were booked at the Magnolia St. Police Station.
