Search:

On 11/20/14 at approximately 0830 Hours, I searched Vicente Martinez's Nissan Frontier in the evidence bay at the Magnolia Street Police Station. Evidence Technician S. Lane assisted me by taking digital photographs and then collecting evidence. At the conclusion of my search I noted the following evidence items inside of the truck.

Evidence Items:

I found a fixed blade hunting style knife in the driver side door panel. It was in plain view and easily accessible from the driver's seat. I found another fixed bladed dagger on the driver's seat but concealed underneath the seat cover. This knife would have been easily accessible to the driver's left hand by simply reaching behind his back. There was also a collapsible baton sitting on the front passenger seat. The baton was contained in a nylon holster.

When I opened the lid to the center console I saw a black zippered pouch. Upon opening it I observed numerous, "Shaved keys" typically used to start car ignitions for the purpose of vehicle theft. I also found a very small plastic bag containing several metal BB's. In my experience BB's are often used to break car windows to gain entry during auto thefts.

Electronic Evidence Items:

I noted a light blue laptop case (Soft) containing a laptop in the middle of the rear passenger seat. I also noted a cell phone on the front passenger floorboard and an iPod device sitting in the dashboard console.

All of these items were collected as evidence with the exception of the knives. They were photographed for documentation and left in the vehicle. No other items were noted.
