DETAILS:

On 11-18-14 at 1845 hours, I monitored and assisted Evidence Technician Lane as she charted the duty weapon belonging to witness Officer Adcox, which was completed by 1904 hours. At 1915 hours she charted the duty weapon belonging to involved Officer Ortiz, which was completed by 1935 hours. The procedure took place at the Magnolia Street Police Station. The following is a synopsis of the charting results. For full details of the charting process and photographs, see Evidence Technician Lane's supplemental report.
