REPORT OF INVESTIGATION

DATE: JULY 6, 2011

SUBJECT: Officer Involved Shooting Death of Virgil Millon, which occurred on May 10, 2011

CASE: Riverside Police Department File #P11068393

LOCATION: 11540 Trailway Drive, Riverside

On June 23, 2011, I received a written request from Frank Hauptmann, Manager of the Community Police Review Commission, to conduct a neighborhood canvass at the location of the officer involved shooting death of Virgil Millon. The purpose of the canvass was to search for potential witnesses who had not been located by Riverside Police Department on the day of the incident. If any witnesses were identified, I was asked to conduct a thorough interview and provide a copy of said interview to Riverside Police Department.

In the evening hours of July 2, 2011, and again in the afternoon of July 5, 2011, I attempted to contact every resident on Trailway Drive, as well as Streampoint Court, which is the street just south of the location. Although some residents were not home on either day, I spoke with many people involving the shooting incident. Some individuals refused to open their door, stating they saw nothing and would not make a statement. Other persons talked quite candidly about several things but would then admit that they did not witness the incident. Witness LS, who resides at [REDACTED] Trailway Drive, said that she was not home at the time of the incident but said that most of her neighbors isolated themselves from one another and no one talks to each other. Witness AG, who lives at [REDACTED] Trailway Drive, stated that she was not home during

the shooting but has "heard" that a real estate agent was confronted by Mr. Millon, during the shootings of the previous victims, and was told it was "self defense".

Although I found most of the residents of Trailway Drive to be friendly and talkative, I was unable to locate anyone who had not been interviewed by the Police.

Not one person who resides on Streampoint Court admitted to witnessing the incident.

I will review the officer involved shooting when Riverside Police Department provides me with access to their files.
