62. Narrative of Supplemental Report On 5/10/11 at 1757 hours I responded to 11532 Trailway regarding an unknown trouble call. Dispatch advised shots were being fired and there were reports of at least two people down in the street possibly shot. The caller also stated she was locked in a bathroom with a four-year-old child inside 11532 Trailway. Officer Fishell arrived on scene and broadcasted shots fired and a subject was down.  As I approached the scene I saw a male lying face down in the driveway of 11531 Trailway. Officers were setting a perimeter around the residence and movement could be seen inside the residence. I saw a female lying on her left side on the sidewalk near the at in front of a residence just west of 11532 Trailway. I saw blood on the female and on the sidewalk around the female. I saw a third subject, a male lying in the front yard of the residence just west of 11532 Trailway. The subject was not moving and he too appeared deceased. Because we were unsure who the suspect was I told Officer Curtis to handcuff the male subject which he did. I escorted and cover RFD personnel as they gave medical attention and checked the status of the two people lying in front of the residence just west of 11532 Trailway. RFD personnel pronounced the two subjects deceased and they were escorted out of the scene.

The female victim was lying near a truck parked on the south curb of Trailway. I saw numerous bullet casings in the street around the truck and I saw two silver magazines on the ground. In the driveway of 11532 Trailway I could see numerous drops of blood.

Dispatch was still communicating with a female inside 11532 Trailway. The female said she was with a child and they were locked in the bathroom. Sergeant Corbett put together a rescue team and moved towards the front door. As this occurred I could see an older blonde female standing in the living room of 11532 Trailway. The female walked to the front door and unlocked it. I stood by with the female by the garage as the rescue team entered the residence. Another adult female and a child were located in a downstairs bathroom. I escorted both adult females and the child out of the scene and I put them in a police car until the scene was secured.

I helped Sergeant Corbett with identifying and securing the crime scene. Officers were directed to put up crime scene tape to protect the crime scenes. Witnesses from 11532 and 11531 Trailway were taken to the Magnolia Street Station to be interviewed by detectives. RFD supplied us with two EZ UPS which we used to shield the two deceased subjects from the public. After the scene was secured I directed Officer Stucker to turn off the COBAN systems on all the units at the scene. See Officer Stuckers supplemental report for details of which units he turned off and the times.
