Interview of Witness Garcia

W-Garcia was interviewed at the Magnolia Station. The interview was digitally recorded and later downloaded into the department server.

Garcia is a pool equipment repair man. He said he had a job assigned at V-Arabella's house.

Garcia said he arrived to fix the pool equipment, which was on the left side of the house (If looking at the house from the street). He said he saw a guy barbequing. He later learned that his name is Marvin. He said he was there for no more than two minutes, when he heard two women screaming. He said Marvin came around the corner and told him to run. He then heard 16 or 17 gunshots. He and Marvin jumped over the fence towards the front and ran to the right, down the street. He said he and Marvin hid behind a wall.

Garcia said that he then saw two people in front of the house he came from. He said he then saw a black male (Suspect) walking from the house with a handgun in his hand. He said the suspect was calm. He said the suspect started shooting in the opposite direction of him. He said he fired many shots. He said the suspect reloaded, because he heard two gaps between the shots. He said he did not see who the suspect was shooting at. He said he called 911.

Garcia said he saw the cop arrive. He said the cop walked up on the same side of the street he was. It was the same side of the street that the house was on. He saw the cop point his gun towards the suspect. He said he heard one shot coming from the suspect. He said he then saw the cop shoot twice. He said he knew the first shot came from the suspect because the shot sounded different from the cop's gunshot.

Garcia said he did not see the victim's until later. He did not see the suspect shoot the victims.

I asked Garcia if he heard the victim say anything and he said no. He said he heard voices when the cop arrived, but did not know if they were the ones talking.

Garcia had no further information.

12 Q: Okay. Um, this is Detective (Rick) Cobb. It's about 10:02 pm on May 10th.
13 What was your last name again? I'm sorry Clint.

15 A: Garcia.

17 Q: Garcia? It's Clint?
18
19 A: Yeah.

21 Q: You have a middle name?

23 A: (Matthew).

25 Q: And what's your birth date?

27 A: Uh, [REDACTED]

29 Q: And your address?

31 A: Uh, it's - well I just moved. I'm living in an RV park right now. So there's no-
32 it's - I'll give you - I'll give you the address.

34 Q: We gotta get a hold of you - we've got to get a hold of you some how.

36 A: It's 3658 Farnham -- F-A-R-N-H-A-M, Place. It's Riverside.

38 Q: And how about a phone number?

40 A: Uh, I got two. 951...

42 Q: Mm-hm.

48 A: Uh, it's a cell. And then [REDACTED] That's a cell also. I work up here and
49 down in San Diego so I got two different numbers.

51 Q: Okay. Uh, do me a favor. Uh, basically just take me from the beginning. So do
52 you even know these people?

54 A: No. I went there - a buddy of mine um, cleans the pool there.

56 Q: Mm-hm.

58 A: And I - I do repairs so I do - I'm a contractor so they contract work out to me.

60 Q: Mm-hm.

62 A: So I just do there to do a heater repair.
63
64 Q: So you got a job basically is - I mean...
65
66 A: Yeah. Yeah. Exactly. You know? I knocked on the door. No one answered the
67 door. So I went around the back and they were all back there barbecuing and
68 everything. And I was literally there not even two minutes, you know, maybe
69 three at the most. I mean all I had time to do was get the - the - the front cover
70 off the heater. And then I sorta - I just heard two women screaming like - I
71 mean screaming.

73 Q: Mm-hm.
74
75 A: And then um, right after that sh- I mean the guy started firin' off shots. And
76 that's when uh, uh, Marvin came runnin' around the corner.
77
78 Q: Who's Marvin? What's Marvin...
79
80 A: Marvin's the - the guy - the other guy you guys interviewed. The black guy.

82 Q: The black guy in there?
83
84 A: Yeah. Yeah.
85
86 Q: Okay. You know Marvin?
87
88 A: No. No. I don't - I - I only know...

90 Q: (Unintelligible).

92 A: Yeah. Because he - he couldn't talk and so he gave me the - his phone to call
93 911 and 911 (unintelligible).
94
95 Q: So Marvin came around the corner?
96
97 A: Yeah he came around the corner and uh, just told me to run. He's like, "This
98 guy's shootin'." And I was like, "What?" And - and I just - I mean - I - I said,
99 "What?" And then ran. I mean jumped over the fence. And um, went down
100 about two or three houses on the other side of the street and we're just hiding
101 behind the house pretty much. You know and he came - he came out front and
102 I mean the guy - I mean the guy was just shooting. I mean he was - I mean
103 there must have been at least sixteen or seventeen shots.

105 Q: You saw him shooting outside?
106
107 A: Yeah.
108
109 Q: Okay.
110
111 A: 'Cause we were both kinda looking around the corner, you know. And then -
112 and if he came out in the front there was still - the two people were out there. I
113 didn't se- really see what they were doing but - 'cause I went - I went back
114 into the backyard at that point. I was like I'm not - I'm not gonna get wrapped
115 up in this.

117 Q: Mm-hm.
118
119 A: I'm just here to fix a heater.
120
121 Q: Mm-hm. So you saw two people? Did you see 'em run outside?
122
123 A: No. No. I didn't - I saw - I saw the guy kinda walkin' out. And I didn't see
124 where the girl was or where the guy was at the time. I just saw him he was
125 walkin'. He was calm as heck. I mean he wasn't runnin' around or anything.
126 He just...

128 Q: He walked right out of the house?
129
130 A: Yeah just walked right out.
131
132 Q: You saw him come out of the house?
133
134 A: Yeah. Yeah.
135

136 Q: Did he have a gun in his hand?
137
138 A: Yeah. Yeah.

140 Q: Okay. And he just - what did he do when you saw him?
141
142 A: He - he was ju- he was just shootin' all over the darn place.
143
144 Q: Started shooting all over?
145
146 A: Yeah. I didn't see the people.
147
148 Q: Was he shooting at anybody?
149
150 A: I think he was shooting at the people. But where I was standing - 'cause I was
151 kinda lookin' behind - behind Marvin there so I couldn't see too much. I saw
152 him coming - walking out. And he turned had his back to us and was firing
153 down the opposite - opposite end of the street.
154
155 Q: Let me - let me ask you a question so I got my perspective here. Let's say you
156 were in the back yard of this house. You run out of the house...
157
158 A: I jumped right over that...
159
160 Q: ...go to the street.
161
162 A: I jumped right over that back fence right there (unintelligible).
163
164 Q: Okay. So now you're facin' the street?
165
166 A: Yes.
167
168 Q: Which way did you go right or left?
169
170 A: I went to the right.
171
172 Q: You went to the right?
173
174 A: Yeah. Towards the - towards the uh, the entrance to the community is where
175 we went to. And we were down about three houses on the other side of the
176 street.
177
178 Q: Okay. You saw him come out. Which way was he shooting towards you or
179 towards the other way?
180

181 A: Other way. Other direction.
182
183 Q: Okay. Just firing a lot of shots?
184
185 A: Yeah. Yeah.
186
187 Q: Just boom, boom, boom, boom, boom, boom, boom?
188
189 A: Yes. Yeah. Yeah. I mean I - I mean I'm like when's the guy gonna run out of
190 bullets?
191
192 Q: Did it seem like maybe he stopped and reloaded.
193
194 A: Uh, he - he reloaded. He had to have reloaded.
195
196 Q: Did you hear him stop shooting?
197
198 A: Yeah. There was - there was - there was two different gaps in the shooting.
199 There was one after he first jumped over the fence everything kinda stopped.
200 And then like that's when he looked around the corner and then he came
201 walking out and started shootin' all over again. And then there was another
202 brief second of stop firing and he fired about three more. And that's when the
203 cop came, you know. And he came running up...

205 Q: Did you see him actually shooting at these people at all or...
206
207 A: No. No.
208
209 Q: Right.
210
211 A: No. As soon as I saw him walking out I ducked back behind around the corner
212 again.
213
214 Q: Then you saw the cop came?
215
216 A: Yeah. I saw the cop coming. There was one other shot - I heard one other shot
217 and then the gu- it sound like the cop...
218
219 Q: What'd you see the cop do?
220
221 A: The cop was out on the same side of the street as the house - the house
222 actually. About probably three - two houses down. He's almost right across
223 from us. And um, he was kinda hidin' behind a pillar. And um, he was
224 watching the dude. I mean I seen him. I couldn't see the guy but he was

225 pointing at him. And then I heard one shot and then you saw like the cop fired
226 I think like twice at him.

228 Q: Did - you saw the cop fire twice?

229
230 A: Yeah. He was - he was right directly across from us.

231
232 Q: You heard one shot.

233
234 A: Yeah.

235
236 Q: So you think that might've come from the bad guy?

237
238 A: Probably I would imagine so. 'Cause it didn't sound the same as the cop's
239 gun.

240
241 Q: Okay.

242
243 A: The cop's gun was a lot - not as loud. That guy's gun was loud. I don't know
244 what kind of gun it was but it was - I mean at first I thought it was M80s. I'm
245 like what the hell are these people doin'?

246
247 Q: Mm-hm. So you call the - saw the cop shoot twice.

248
249 A: Yeah.

250
251 Q: What'd you see after that?

252
253 A: Psh, that was - that was it. They just told us, you know, stay down. Stay over
254 where you're at. I see...

256 Q: Did you ever see the two victims?

257
258 A: Yeah.

260 Q: You...

262 A: Yeah.

264 Q: Afterwards or you just...

266 A: Yeah...

268 Q: Okay.

270 A: ...afterwards.

272 Q: Afterwards.

274 A: I saw the one girl under my truck and...
275
276 Q: But you didn't see 'em down beforehand?
277
278 A: No.
279
280 Q: You didn't see this shoot at 'em or anything like that?
281
282 A: Nuh-uh. No.
283
284 Q: Okay.
285
286 A: I never even saw the dude's face. It just - as he was coming out I saw - I mean
287 I saw - he was far - too far away from me to really get a good look at him, you
288 know. But I saw him coming out and he had a gun in his hand. And that's
289 when I back behind a wall again.
290
291 Q: Did you hear him say anything - the bad guy?
292
293 A: Didn't hear a word. All I heard - the first thing I heard was like a lot of
294 screaming.
295
296 Q: Any - any particular voices or anything?
297
298 A: No.
299
300 Q: Just screamin'?
301
302 A: It was the - you know I - it - it sounded like the girl, you know, the girl that -
303 because the younger girl - not the mom that was in the bad guys...
304
305 Q: I remember.
306
307 A: ...talked to the mom and it sounded like it was the mom and the younger girl
308 that were both screamin'.
309
310 Q: Okay. But then...
311
312 A: Man they - they were screamin' bloody murder.
313
314 Q: So you just heard screaming first then you heard the gunshot?

315
316 A: And then I heard two shots - two or three shots. And that's when the guy came
317 around the corner....
318
319 Q: Could you tell where the gunshots were coming from inside the house or
320 outside the house?
321
322 A: You could - well it sounded like he was - like where I was sq- I was squatted
323 down right in front of the heater there. And there's a - and there was a little
324 section there and it sou- I mean it sounded like they had thrown - like it
325 sounded like a foot or two from me. I mean that's why I thought it was...
326
327 Q: So it sounded like outside?
328
329 A: Yeah it was definitely outside. That's why I thought it was an M80 or
330 something, you know, 'cause I mean it was - it was - I mean almost right next
331 to me it seemed like.
332
333 Q: Okay. Did they sound like different calibers?
334
335 A: No. They all sounded the same.
336
337 Q: They sounded the same?
338
339 A: Yeah. Yeah.
340
341 Q: So you just - you just heard multiple shots.
342
343 A: Yeah.
344
345 Q: Ten, 20, 30, 40?
346
347 A: Uh, no I'd say like 16, 17.
348
349 Q: Okay.
350
351 A: Somewhere in that range. He must have - he probably went off about six to
352 eight times in the back yard. And then he came back out front and must have
353 done another eight to ten out front.
354
355 Q: Okay.
356
357 A: So.
358
359 Q: All right.

360
361 A: Yeah. He was just shootin' away though.
362
363 Q: So really - I mean not - not too much to it. You showed up for a job.
364
365 A: Yep.
366
367 Q: You went right to the back?
368
369 A: Mm-hm.
370
371 Q: Who did you see when you went back there?
372
373 A: Well I first went back there I saw Marvin was standing in the sliding glass
374 doorway right there. And then um, I told him, "Hey. I'm just here to fix the
375 heater." He's like, "Oh go ahead it's right around the corner there." And then I
376 went around the corner. And then the girl wound up underneath my truck. She
377 came over. She's like, "Oh you..."
378
379 Q: Was somebody barbecuin'?
380
381 A: Yeah they were barbecuin'. Yeah.
382
383 Q: Who was?
384
385 A: Uh, Marvin was.
386
387 Q: Marvin barbecuin'?
388
389 A: Yeah. Chicken. Smelled darn good too.
390
391 Q: And you saw - also saw a female outside?
392
393 A: Um, yeah. Yeah. She came out and came over and talked to me real quick.
394 And I just told her who I was, you know, 'cause she didn't see me walk by
395 only Marvin did.
396
397 Q: Okay.
398
399 A: I assumed he said hey the pool guy's here, you know. And she came out.
400 She's like, "Oh your - goodness you're here to fix the heater." And then she
401 went back in. And she was - like I said she wasn't gone from...
402
403 Q: So she was inside?
404

405 A: Well she went back around the corner I should say.
406
407 Q: Okay.
408
409 A: She went back around the corner. Where I was I couldn't see the backyard,
410 you know.
411
412 Q: Yeah.
413
414 A: 'Cause I'm sittin' right there in front of that heater there. And um, and so she
415 walked around the corner and not even a minute later she started screamin'.
416
417 Q: Okay. When Marvin said, "Get out of here," you had already heard the shots?
418
419 A: Yeah.
420
421 Q: Okay.
422
423 A: Yeah. He came - he - he came around the corner. I think there was probably
424 one shot and he was around the corner. And there was multiple shots. And
425 then he's like run. I'm like, "What is that?" And he's all, "Just run." And so
426 we both jumped over that brick wall and took off.
427
428 Q: Okay. You jumped. You went to the right.
429
430 A: Yeah.
431
432 Q: A couple doors down. You hung out for a minute then you saw - you didn't
433 see the two people come out. You only saw him.
434
435 A: No.
436
437 Q: And he was walking calmly?
438
439 A: Yeah. Yeah.
440
441 Q: The gun to his side or...
442
443 A: No rush. No rush. It was - it wasn't - it was - it wasn't pointed out in front of
444 him but it was like - it was like halfway in between, you know, he was - he
445 was just...
446
447 Q: Nice and calm...
448
449 A: Yeah. Then he just...

450
451 Q: ...looking around then he started shooting at somebody. You don't know who?
452
453 A: Yeah. Yeah as soon as I saw him come walking out the front I ducked around
454 the corner again 'cause I didn't want him to see me. And then he came in the
455 same way I came in through that back gate over there.
456
457 Q: Okay. All right.
458
459 A: So...
460
461 Q: And you didn't see who he was shooting at. You just - you saw the cop show
462 up?
463
464 A: Yeah.
465
466 Q: Did you hear the cop give any commands at all?
467
468 A: Um, I did not hear him. I was on the phone with 911 at the time too so he may
469 have said something.
470
471 Q: You called 911?
472
473 A: Yeah. Well Marvin called 911 and he couldn't talk. He like - he was all
474 freaked out so I took the phone from him 'cause both my phones are in my
475 truck. But yeah I didn't hear the cop say anything.
476
477 Q: Okay.
478
479 A: But I mean he could've. I was - I was on the phone so I was...
480
481 Q: And you heard one shot probably from the bad guy?
482
483 A: Yeah. It was - it was definitely a louder pop. And then...
484
485 Q: But you didn't see where the one shot came from?
486
487 A: No. Nu-huh
488
489 Q: And then you say the co- you actually saw him fire twice?
490
491 A: Yeah. The cop was right across from us.
492
493 Q: Okay. You saw the victims afterwards.
494

495 A: Yeah.
496
497 Q: And that was pretty much it.
498
499 A: Yeah.
500
501 Q: Okay.
502
503 A: Yeah.
504
505 Q: Okay. Unless you can...

507 A: (Unintelligible).

509 Q: ...unless you can think of anything else I...

513 Q: Okay.

515 A: Not that I can think of.
