Continued:

Upon arrival, I made my way up to the apartment in question and took up a post on the north east side. I took this position over from Det. Fernandez and Sgt. Ramaekers. Det. Simons, Ofcr. Asbury and Ofcr. Lucero also maintained position at this location with me.

While holding this position, Ofcr. Watkins and I found a way into the apartment directly across from the suspects apartment. To attempt to gather a better visual on the apartment, Ofcr. Watkins and I entered the rear bedroom of apartment #Q243 and made our way to the front door. We slightly opened the front door and found that the suspect's front door was still wide open. While maintaining a tactical hold on this position, we heard a male voice yelling from inside that he was shot in his legs and that he could not walk. Under the command of the Incident Command Post, Ofcr. Watkins and I took turns attempting to talk to the male and have him exit the apartment, exposing his hands, so that we may offer him medical aid and speak with him. The male continued to say he was hurt and that he could not walk and he needed help. Again, we informed him that we wanted to assist him and get him medical aid, but he needed to come to us so that we may render it to him. After approximately 10 minutes of dialogue between us and the suspect, he stopped talking. At this time METRO team Officers arrived and took over our positions.

Although METRO took over our positions, we stayed in apartment #Q243 until they made entry and rendered apartment #Q242 secured. After securing the apartment, Ofcr. Watkins and I were tasked with perimeter security at the entry point to the apartment. I stood this post until I was relieved by Ofcr. Hart at 1400 hours.

Prior to leaving the scene, I gathered left over paperwork left by the METRO team. This paperwork was a copy of the original OPS plan used by SACA detectives. This paperwork was later booked into RPD Lincoln Station as evidence. Also, while on scene, O1/Walsh had approached the perimeter and advised me that she had located a shotgun shell casing approximately 120 yards east of the south side of the perimeter. O1/Walsh escorted me down to where she located it and said that it was laying in the street and she thought that we would want to know about it. I recovered the shell casing and found it to be a 12 gauge expended casing. This casing did not appear to be related to the shooting, but was recovered and later booked into evidence at RPD Lincoln Station at the request of Sgt. Amador. No further information at this time.
