**Details:**

On 11-16-11 at approximately 0800 hours, I was assigned as a SWAT operator to the Riverside Police Department's METRO Team. On the above date and time, I responded to a full METRO call-out regarding an 11-99/Officer involved shooting at 10406 Indiana Ave., in the city and county of Riverside. The suspect was suspected of being armed and barricaded inside the apartment 242 at the listed location.

Upon my arrival at the scene, I was assigned to the arrest team inside apartment 243, which was directly across from apartment 242. The arrest team consisted of METRO operators (personnel listed above). Sgt. Whitt was also present as the supervisor for the arrest team.

The arrest team eventually made entry into the apartment 242 through the open front door. An unresponsive male (suspect) was found lying within the hallway of the apartment. After members of the arrest team successfully cleared the apartment and rendered it safe, medical personnel (AMR) was called into the apartment to tend to the suspect. AMR pronounced the suspect deceased, at which time the above listed METRO operators exited the residence. The investigation was turned over to RPD Robbery/Homicide Detectives.
