1 **Interview with W1/Gloria Engebretson:**

2 On 11-16-11, at approximately 1050 hours, Partner Detective Kim Crutchfield and I contacted
3 W1/Gloria Engebretson in her apartment where we interviewed her. The interview was recorded on
4 my department issued digital recorder and later downloaded to laser fiche under the file number used
5 for this supplemental report. Gloria took a moment and put her hearing aids in prior to talking with us.
6 The following is a synopsis of what Gloria said: She has lived there for approximately a year and a
7 half. She knows Margie and Al who live in the apartment straight across from hers. She said she is
8 neighborly with them. If she bakes a cake she will often give some to Margie and Al, and in return
9 they have brought her ribs when they barbeque. She knows that Margie works for a cardiologist and
10 goes to work in the early morning. Al is usually gone in the morning and then returns later. She
11 thinks he walks in the mall. She believes Al worked for the county for 20-years and then got laid off.
12 She thinks both Margie and Al are in their late fifties. She has been inside their apartment once or
13 twice. She said they had to downsize when they moved there and they have a lot of stuff in their
14 apartment. Margie drives a small red car (possibly a Chevy). She said Al drives the car parked to the
15 front of the apartment. She believes Margie has a daughter and a son. She has seen their little 1-
16 year-old grandson, [REDACTED] She said Margie and Al are nice people and she has never known them to
17 get loud or not get along. She said she has not seen them much lately. She said Margie was down
18 for 10-days with the flu and then she had heard Al was sick. She said Al has seemed a little "edgy"
19 and down lately.

21 This morning she was awake and in her pajamas. She believes she stepped out to get the paper
22 around 7:00 a.m. Later she heard loud pounding and opened her door. She saw three police officers
23 wearing vests and their guns were drawn. Margie and Al's door to their apartment was standing open.
24 A lady police officer told her to go back inside her apartment. She went back inside and was walking
25 to the back of her apartment when she heard gun shots; at least fifteen (15). She called her son on
26 the phone and he told her to go to the back bedroom and stay there. A police officer outside her
27 apartment motioned for her to get away from the window. Later a police officer pounded on her den
28 window and said, "We are evacuating you." They assisted her through the den window. She said she
29 wears hearing aids, which she did not have in. She described the sounds of the gun shots as a
30 popping noise.

33 **Interview with W2/Juvronia Jackson:**

34 On 11-16-11, at approximately 1150 hours, Partner Detective Kim Crutchfield and I contacted W2/
35 Juvronia Jackson and interviewed her in her apartment. The interview was recorded with my
36 department issued digital recorder and later downloaded to laser fiche under the file number used for
37 this supplemental report. The following is a synopsis of what Juvronia said: She has lived in her
38 apartment for about 10-years. She had heard on the news there had been a police incident that
39 occurred in the apartment complex. She did not hear or see anything. I showed Juvronia pictures of
40 S/Alfred Romo and his wife, Margie Romo. She said she did not recognize either of them and does
41 not recall seeing them before.
