**Narrative**

On 05-10-11 I responded to 11532 Trailway in the City of Riverside reference a shooting. I arrived at approximately 1900 hrs and saw the area secured with yellow crime scene tape. I attended a briefing given by Patrol Sgt Corbett who told us that officers responded to the area for numerous calls of shots being fired. The first officer on scene encountered a male subject, later identified as S-Millon, in front of 11540 Trailway. S-Millon was firing a handgun at close range at a female on the ground later identified as V-Bradford. The uniformed officer fired at S-Millon several times, ultimately striking him and taking him into custody. Another shooting victim was located in the front yard at 11532 Trailway. Both victims were pronounced deceased at the scene. S-Millon was transported to a local hospital where he later died.

Officers located a revolver in the back yard at 11532 Trailway and a semi-auto handgun in the front yard of 11531 Trailway. Numerous rounds had been fired at several locations in the immediate area.

Patrol officers at the scene determined that S-Millon had been living at 11531 Trailway Drive. Five people were located inside that residence and they were transported to the Magnolia Police Station while officers secured the scene on Trailway. Det Rick Wheeler was assigned as Case Agent and Det Simons and Det Brandt were assigned to process the scene on Trailway. I was asked to respond to the Magnolia Police Station to begin interviews with the occupants of 11531 Trailway.

Upon arrival at the Station I contacted O1 Jeff Stern, O2 Ruth Stern, O3 Harold Smith, O4 Kenneth Griffith and O5 Marie Griffith in the lobby. I learned that O1 and O2 Stern owned the home at 11531 Trailway and they live there with O2's elderly Uncle, O3 Smith. O4 and O5 Griffith were friends of the Sterns that were visiting. S-Millon was living in a room in the house and was employed by the Stern's in their home based business in pet supplies.

I interviewed O1 Jeff Stern, O4 Kenneth Griffith and O5 Marie Griffith. O3 Harold Smith is 97 years old and is very hard of hearing. O1 Stern told me that O3 Smith was upstairs in his room when the incident occurred and he would have been oblivious to anything going on outside.

### Interviews

All interviews were recorded and downloaded to the RPD server under this file number.

None of the persons I interviewed actually saw anyone shooting. The Griffiths had come over to the Stern's house because they were going to go to dinner together. They had to wait before they left because UPS was supposed to pick up some boxes from the house relating to their pet supply business. Normally S-Millon would be there to do it but he had gone somewhere that afternoon and wasn't back yet.

O1 Jeff Stern told me that S-Millon and V-Bradford were their neighbors across the street (at 11532 Trailway) until a few years ago. S-Millon was accused of domestic violence against V-Bradford and he was arrested as a result of it and briefly jailed. O1 Stern told me that shortly after the incident occurred V-Bradford came to him and told him she had made up the whole thing against S-Millon, and she wanted to know what he thought she should do. O1 Stern said he told V-Bradford to tell the police immediately, and apparently she did, because the case was eventually dropped. As far as O1 Stern knew the police located an illegal firearm in the house when they arrested S-Millon and that was the only charge that he was convicted of. S-Millon lost his job as a result of the arrest. S-Millon was staying at various friends' houses so O1 Stern offered to let him stay in their house in a spare room downstairs and he offered him a job helping with their pet supply home business. The business is run out of the garage. S-Millon agreed and moved it.

O1 Stern said that since S-Millon has lived with them he has been very nice and is a good tenant. He has been very reliable in their business. S-Millon has always tried to avoid any problems with V-Bradford, but in O1 Stern's opinion, V-Bradford had been trying to make S-Millon's life miserable. O1 felt that V-Bradford may have been bi-polar because since he has

known her she has had pretty wild mood swings. One day she was very nice, and the next she might be screaming at you for no reason. He cited an example; Six months ago V-Bradford came up to him while he was in his driveway and started screaming at him. She was telling him that she has "been going to the range with her gun" and she is "a pretty good shot now." She also said that her friends are good shots too, and then she left. O1 Stern said that V-Bradford was accusing him of spying on her for S-Millon, and he took what she said as a threat.

O1 Stern said that he was aware that there was some type of legal action that V-Bradford had recently initiated against S-Millon, because yesterday (5-09-11) a process server came to the house looking for S-Millon. S-Millon wasn't home so the process server left the paperwork stuck in the door. S-Millon came home later that day and told O1 that V-Bradford was trying to get a restraining order against him. Today (05-10-11), S-Millon took off in his truck somewhere with some paperwork of his own, and was gone for most of the afternoon. S-Millon was still gone when the Griffiths came over.

Based on my interviews I learned that both couples were seated in the living room just before the incident. The 97 year old Uncle was in his room upstairs. They were all waiting for the UPS guy to get there, and when he did O1 Stern went outside. When he got out there he saw that S-Millon was back and helping the UPS guy, so O1 Stern went back in the house. O1 sat back down in the living room to wait until UPS left. They were still seated in the living room when O5 Marie Griffith said she saw S-Millon come into the house from the garage and go to his room. He came back out a few minutes later and went back into the garage. O5 didn't see whether S-Millon had anything in his hands when he left, and nobody else saw him because of where they were seated. A few minutes later they all heard what they thought was gunfire outside, so they got up to go to the front door to see what was going on. When they reached the door they realized that there was a lot of gunfire still going on, so they decided to go upstairs until it stopped. They never saw who was shooting. Shortly after the shooting stopped they noticed that there were a lot of police pointing their guns at their house. They called 911 to let them know they were inside. The police had them exit the residence one at a time and they were taken to the police station. As they exited they saw S-Millon apparently shot in the drive way, and two other bodies across the street.

#### **Search of S-Millon's bedroom at 11531 Trailway**

O1 and O2 Stern agreed to let officers look anywhere inside their house to complete our investigation, including S-Millon's room. They both said they did not believe that S-Millon had any weapons in his room. Det Medici transported the Stern's and O3 Smith back to the residence. Det Medici and I then searched S-Millon's bedroom, which was the only bedroom located downstairs, and Det Simons searched the garage.

Det Medici located an empty hard gun case for a Ruger P95 pistol in the nightstand on the left side of the bed. In a drawer under the bathroom sink he located an empty soft pistol case, a box of live .38 rounds with some missing and a clear bag with some loose .38 rounds.

Approximately (6) bottles of prescription sleeping aids (Ambien etc.) were located on the nightstand and in the bathroom. These were collected for destruction.

Evidence Tech Tim Ellis took photos of the evidence and then collected it.
