### CURRENT SITUATION

*(Recent updates are posted at the top of Current Situation)*

On January 8th, 2017 at 8:09 p.m. Engine Company 8 was dispatched to a report of a natural gas leak coming from the street in the 11000 block of Springway Ct. Engine 8 arrived to find a natural gas leak from an underground supply line along with a water line break. The street had lifted approx. 2 inches in the area of the break. One residential house was evacuated displacing 4 persons along with 14 residential houses sheltering in place. Southern California Gas and Riverside Public Utilities responded to the incident to mitigate. Out of precaution the natural gas was shut off at each meter to the 15 residential houses affected to avoid water entering into the broken natural gas pipe and into the appliances of the residential houses. RPU crews will be working with Southern California Gas through the night to mitigate and repair the street. It is unknown if the rain caused the incident. The four displaced persons took shelter with family.
