### CURRENT SITUATION

*(Recent updates are posted at the top of Current Situation)*

The City of Riverside Fire Department responded to a report of a traffic collision with possible victims trapped at the intersection of La Sierra and Cypress. The first due Engine Company reported 2 vehicles, both on their sides with one against a tree, and another against a house. Both had major damage. The captain requested an additional engine company and an additional AMR unit to assist. City of Riverside firefighters immediately began treating a male patient of unknown age that had been ejected from his vehicle. The patient was transported by AMR in critical condition to an area hospital. The occupant of the second vehicle contained a female of unknown age. The female victim was dead at the scene and was not transported. The two cars collided in the intersection at a high rate of speed, causing both vehicles to tumble off the roadway. One vehicle ended up against a tree, while the second came to rest on its side against a house. Riverside City Firefighters stabilized the vehicle resting against the house so that RPD and the Riverside County Coroner could conduct their investigation and removal of the deceased female. The city of Riverside Police Departments Major Accident Investigation Unit responded to the scene to conduct the investigation.
